HES serves approximately 450 students in grades PreK through 5. We have a diverse student body with an increasing population of military families from Naval Air Station Pax River. At HES, we set high expectations for all students with a standards-based curriculum that's progressive and challenging. Our vision and goals are focused on partnership, creating a safe school environment, and increasing academic achievement. Hollywood Elementary School has been identified as a Targeted Support and Improvement school for our Special Education Sub-group performance. Schools are identified as TSI if they have at least one student group performing as low as the lowest performing 5% of Title I schools. |
| Equity Vision Statement (approximately 50 words) | Hollywood continues to ensure educational equity by implementing high-quality instruction and maintaining high expectations for all students. Through a focus on standards-based instruction and universal design for learning, staff work to address diverse learners and ensure access to instruction for each student including built-in supports, just in time intervention, and learning extensions. |
| Your School's Key Strengths (approximately 50 words) | At Hollywood, we implement a team approach when addressing student needs, use data to drive instruction, and implement strategies to meet the needs of each student. We set high expectations and collaborate to ensure our goals are met. We ensure students feel comfortable in their learning environment through flexible thinking and a warm, welcoming environment. |
| Progress Made During Prior Year (approximately 50 words) | Hollywood Elementary outperformed the county and state averages in ELA/Literacy for the Spring 2024 MCAP assessment. Looking over the standards assessed in the MCAP ELA/Literacy, HES again outperformed the county and state averages. Reviewing the assessment data from the 2023-2024 school year, HES had gains in Reading Informational Text and Reading Foundational Skills. Additionally, HES increased their writing in all areas: written expression, written conventions, informative/explanatory, and narrative writing. While still outperforming the county average for Fifth Grade Math MCAP by 5%, we are still waiting to see the projected gains in mathematics. Our Fourth-Grade students underperformed the state average; however, there was an 11% growth in mathematics performance from the 2023 school year. Third-grade students continue to outperform the county and state averages in MCAP Math as we outperform their average from the 2023 school year. |
| Areas of Continued Growth for Upcoming Year (approximately 50 words) | Hollywood will continue to focus on the area of Math as our area of growth is not increasing at the same pace as our predicted target. We will continue to focus on student subgroups in need through implementing MTSS principles including targeted small group intervention, co-teaching, implementing UDL, and Conscious Discipline. In an effort to provide more well rounded and rigorous math instruction we will be placing a larger focus on mathematical reasoning. We will continue to focus on more rigorous intervention and support for our Students with Disabilities subgroup. |
