FINANCE

36. The Superintendent recommends and so moves the Board of Education of Sayreville to approve the acceptance of the FY26 Perkins Secondary Consolidated Grant in the amount of \$14,836.00.

- d. On Wednesday, January 14, 2026, forty Sayreville Middle School Social Studies students and five faculty members to Superior Court of New Jersey, New Brunswick, NJ. Students will explore career awareness in the courts. One Board bus will be utilized at a cost of \$297.50 (\$277.50 salary - \$20.00 fuel) to be paid by the Board of Education.
