Established in 1971, Adrian C. Wilcox is a WASC-accredited four-year public comprehensive high school in Santa Clara Valley, approximately 45 miles south of San Francisco. The school is surrounded by private homes and apartments and serves students from Santa Clara, Sunnyvale, and San Jose. Composed of students from a wide variety of social and economic areas, the general economic background is middle class with many parents engaged in skilled, professional or service occupations in Silicon Valley. The certificated staff includes a principal, 3 vice principals, 6 counselors, a librarian, 88 teachers and services from a part time nurse, speech therapist, two psychologists, and LMFT Wellness Coordinator and interns to support our diverse student body. Taking into consideration smaller English Language Learner classes, the average mainstream class size is 28 students. Wilcox High School has a comprehensive curriculum which is primarily designed for the college bound, AP and Honors courses, vocational-technology, special education and English language development. Units of Credit – Ten units of credit are assigned for each course that meets one period daily for one year. Five units of credit are assigned for each course that meets one period daily for one semester.

- A Career Technical Education (CTE) Program with classes ranging from automotive technology to business, fashion design, and culinary careers, many of which the students receive college credit through Mission College
- A nationally recognized Distributive Education Clubs of America (DECA) program and robotics team
- An athletic program with 25 sports teams, a cheer, dance and drill team
- An active AVID program with a section at each grade level
- An outstanding Visual and Performing Arts program that includes a Concert Band, two Orchestras, and a Choir; a drama program with multiple yearly performances and art classes in Ceramics, Sculpture, Drawing and Painting
- 80 student run clubs that vary from Speech and Debate to Best Buddies

GPA and Related Information

- Credit is awarded on a per-semester basis in December and June
- GPA is computed each semester and cumulatively at the end of grades 9, 10, 11 and 12
- GPA is calculated on the following scale: A = 4; B = 3; C=2; D=1; F=0
- Advanced Placement and Honors courses are given an additional point value on the GPA and are noted on the transcript by the course title with an "AP" or "H."

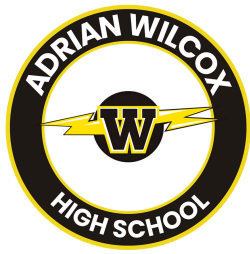
