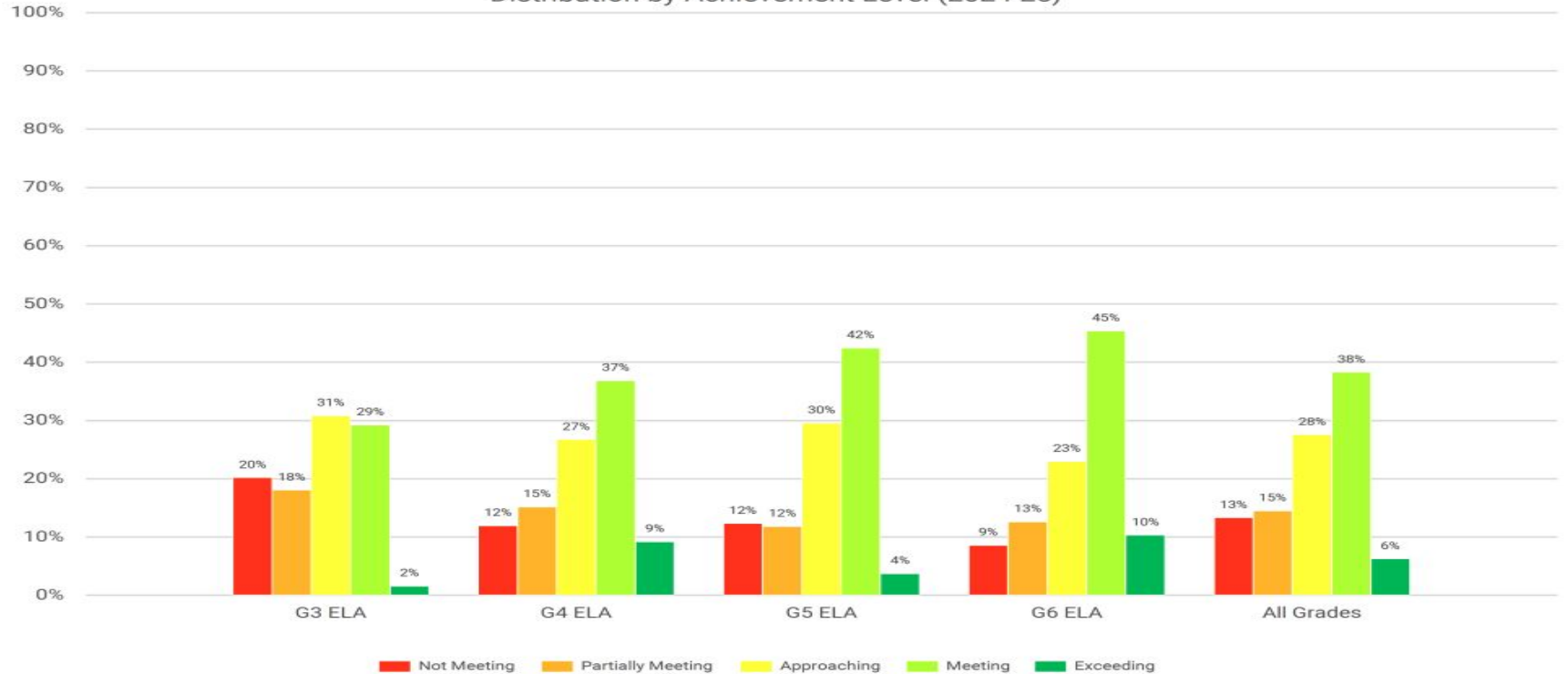

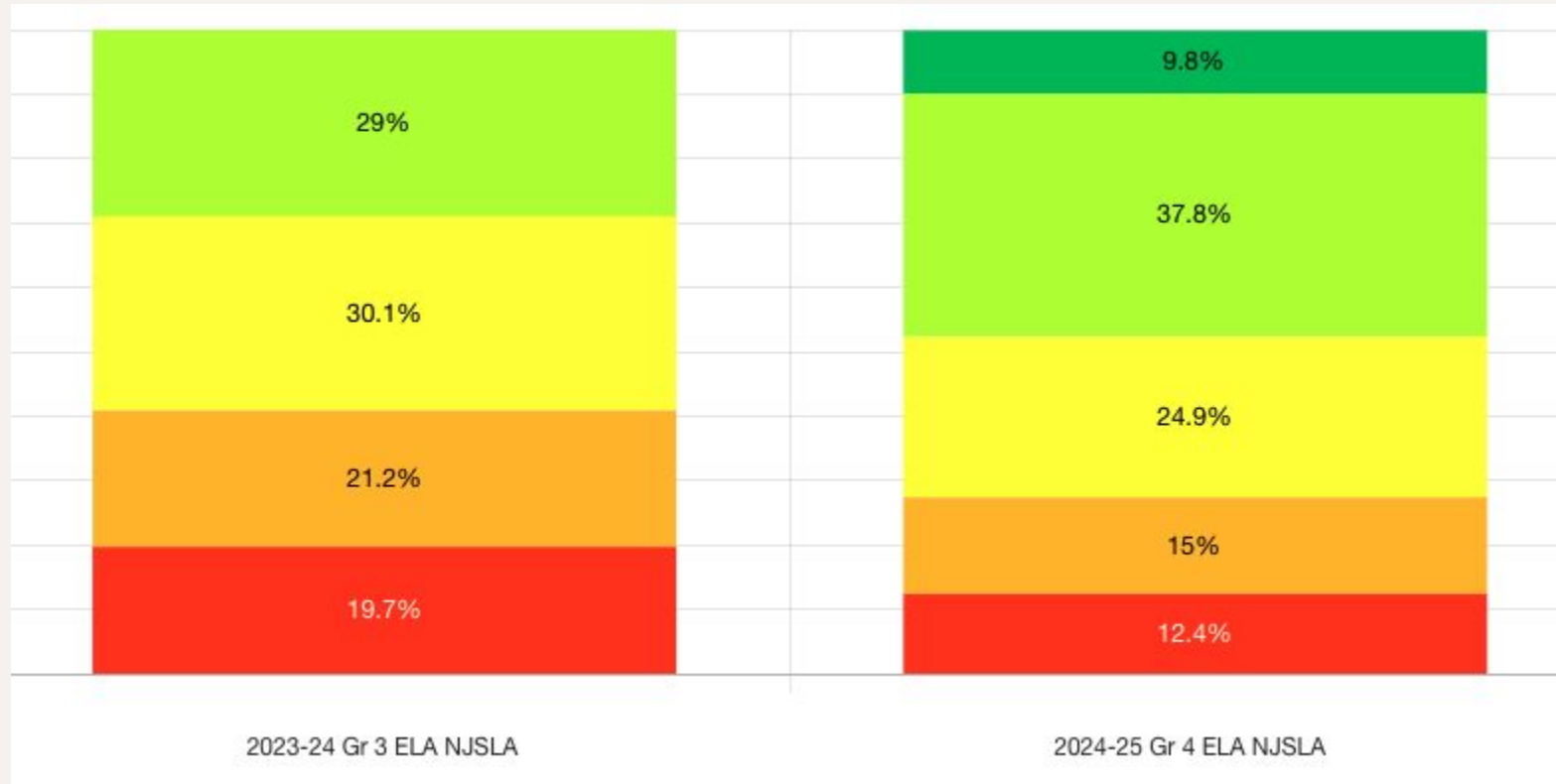

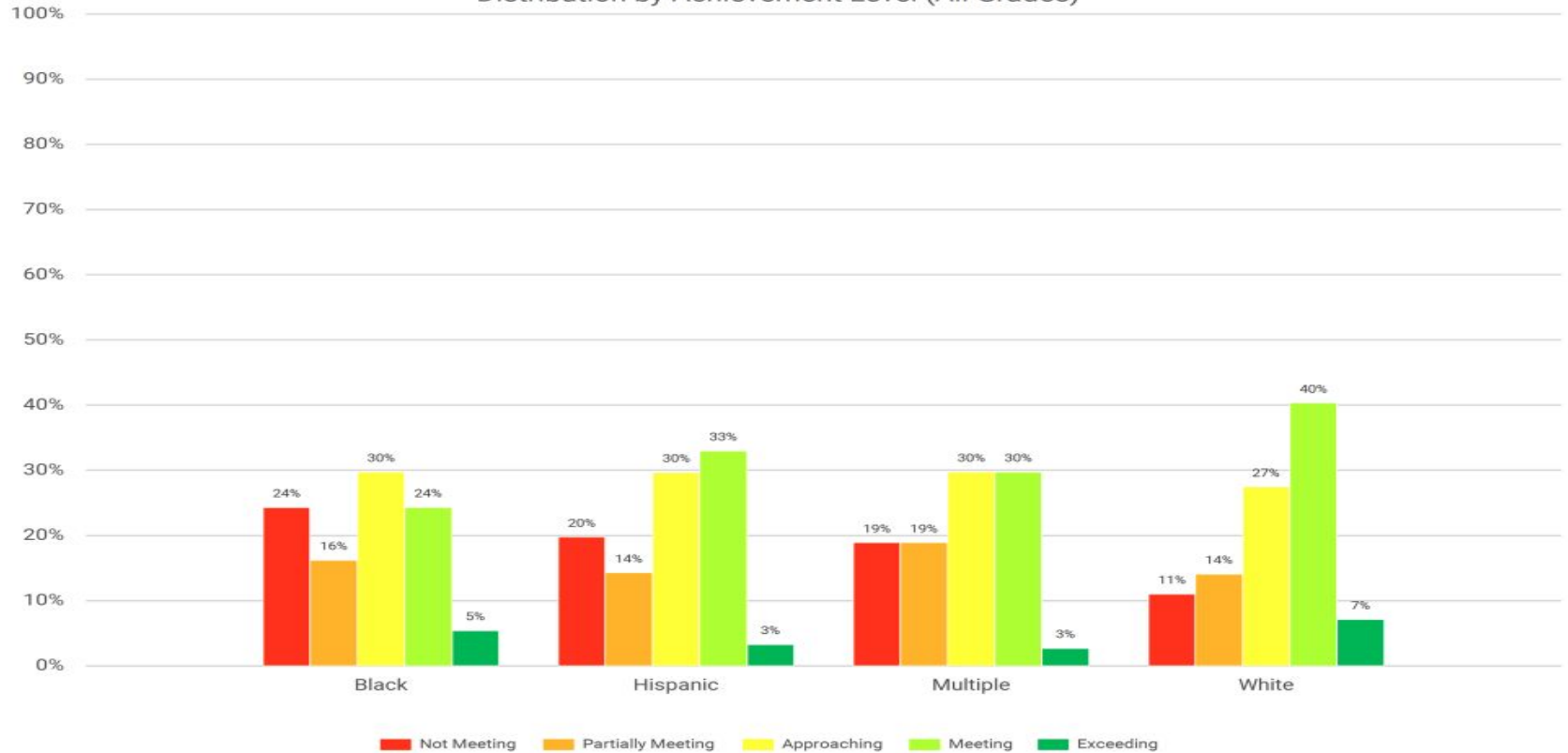

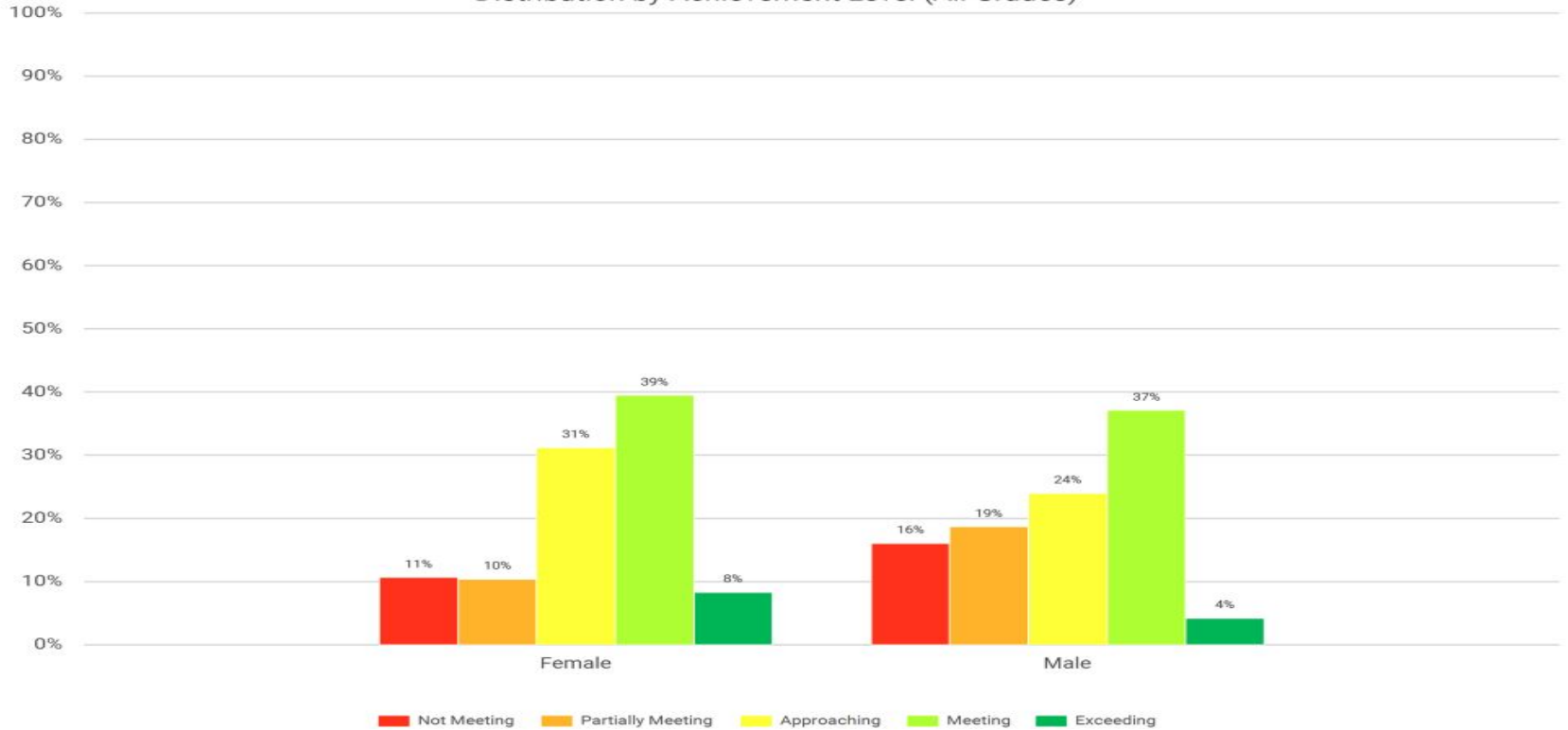
# Little Egg Harbor School District 2024-25 Spring NJSLA by Subgroup Race Language Arts

Distribution by Achievement Level (All Grades)



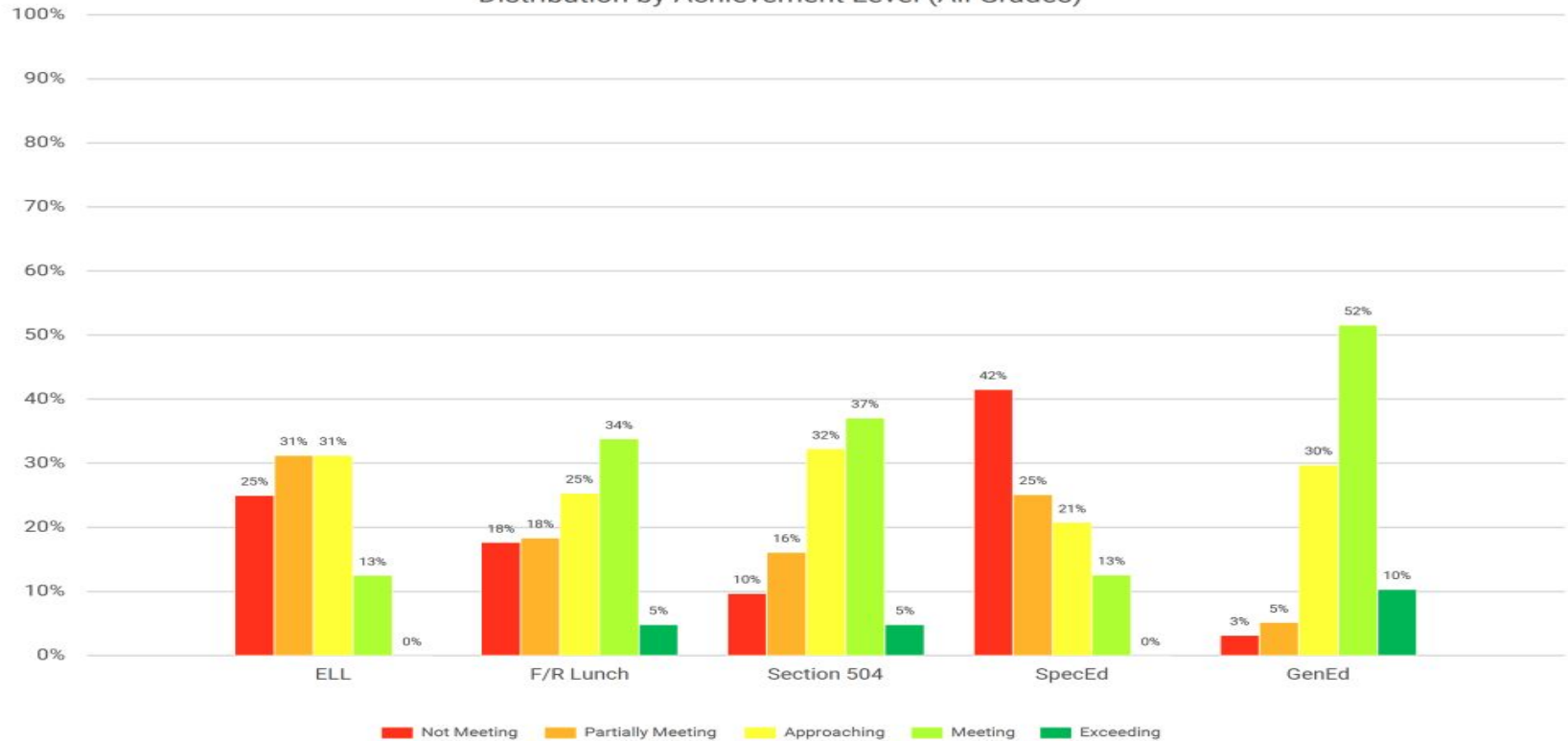
# Little Egg Harbor School District 2024-25 Spring NJSLA by Subgroup Gender Language Arts

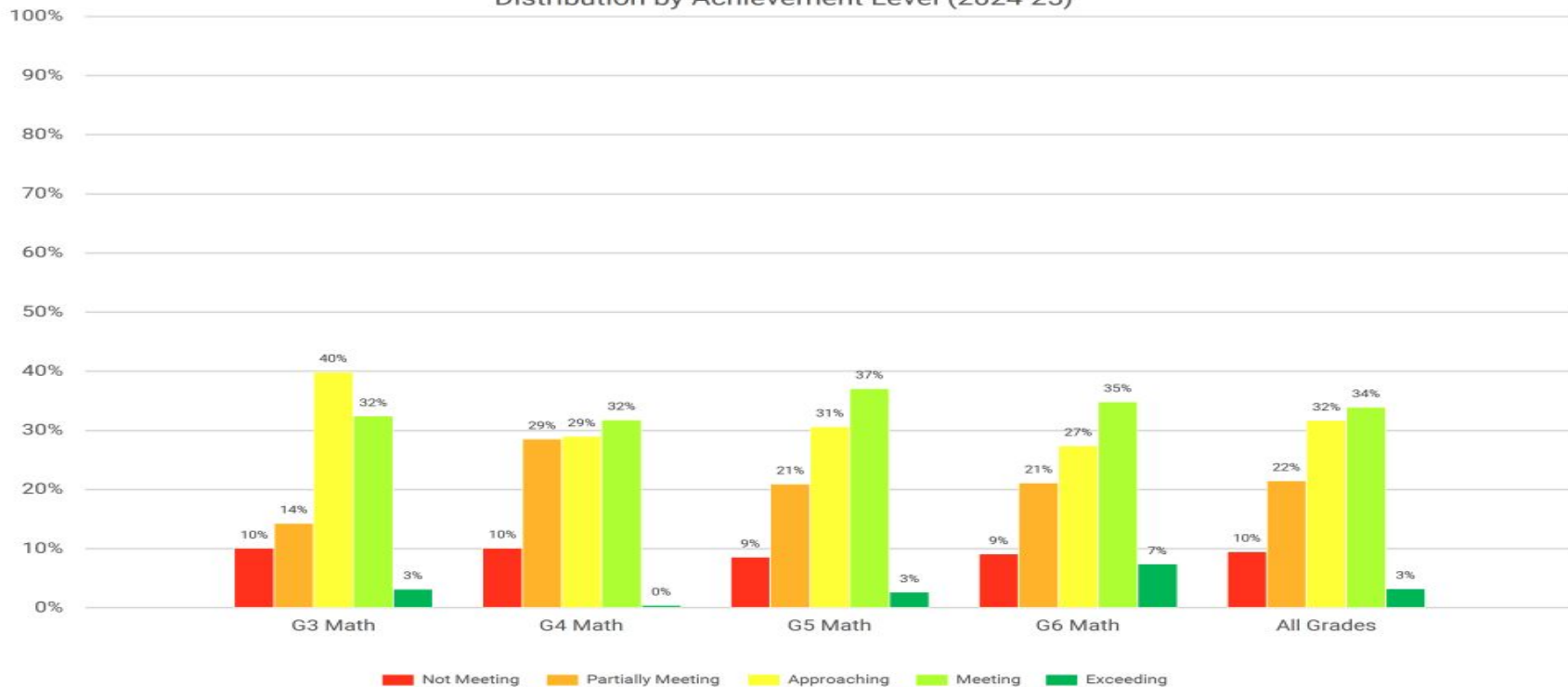

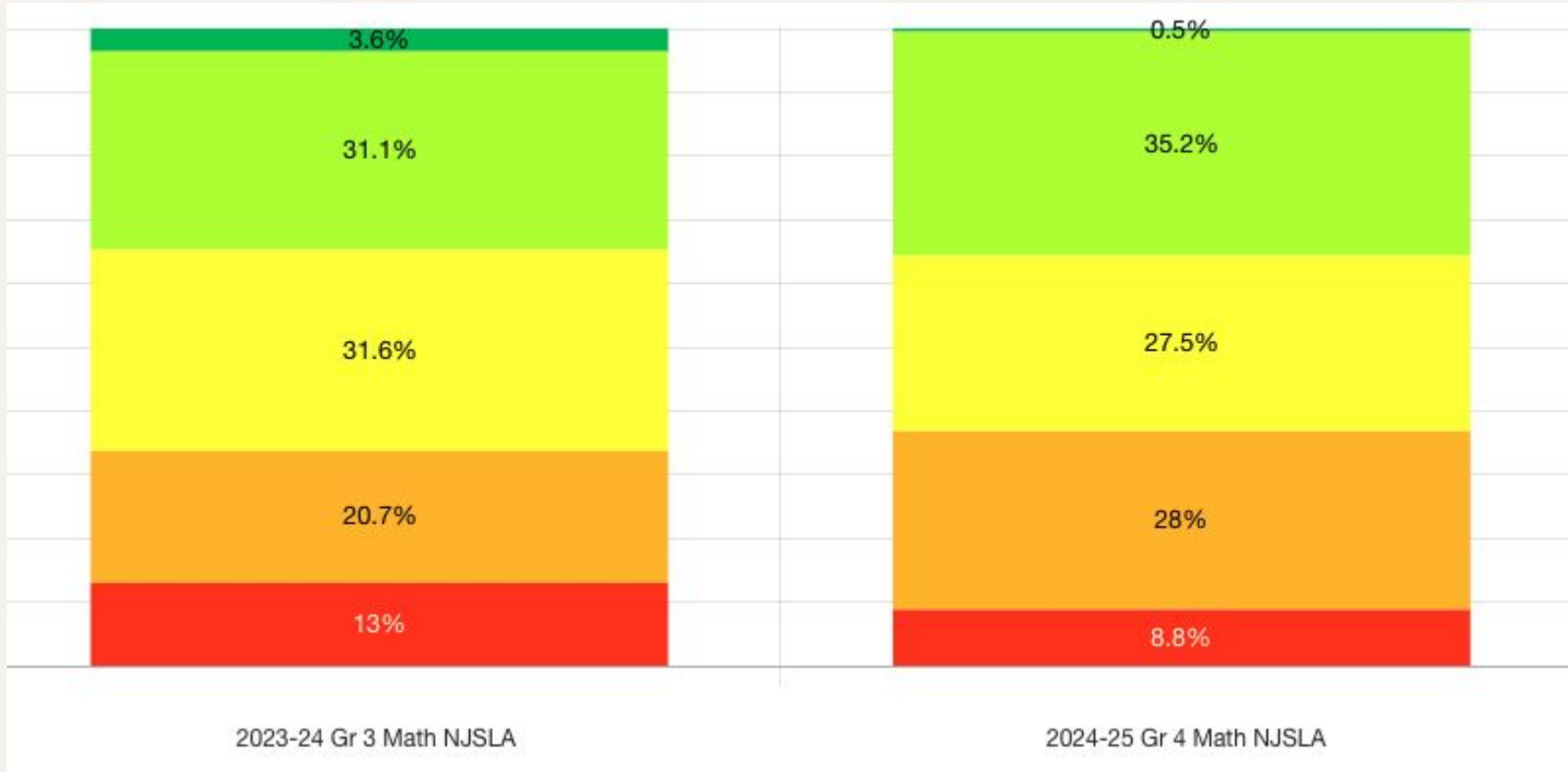

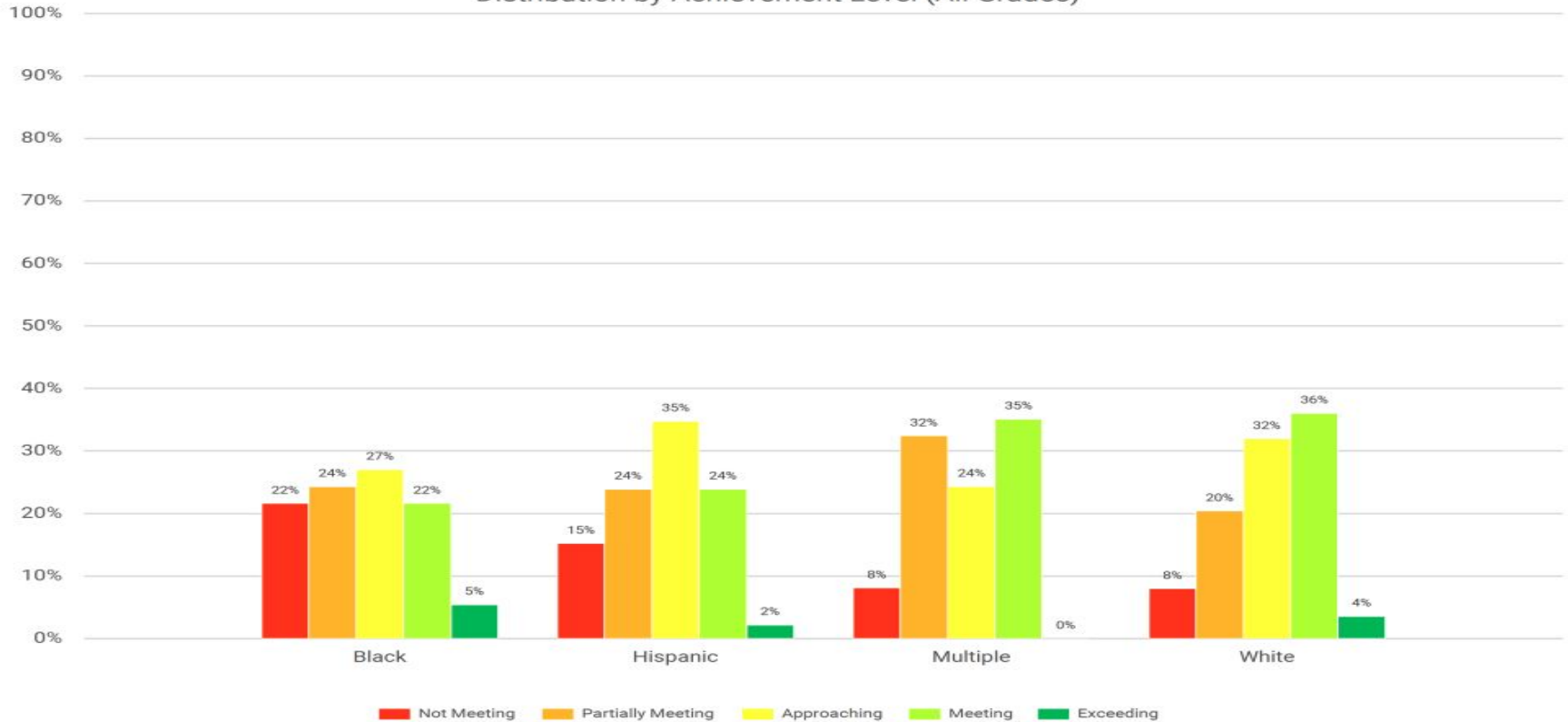

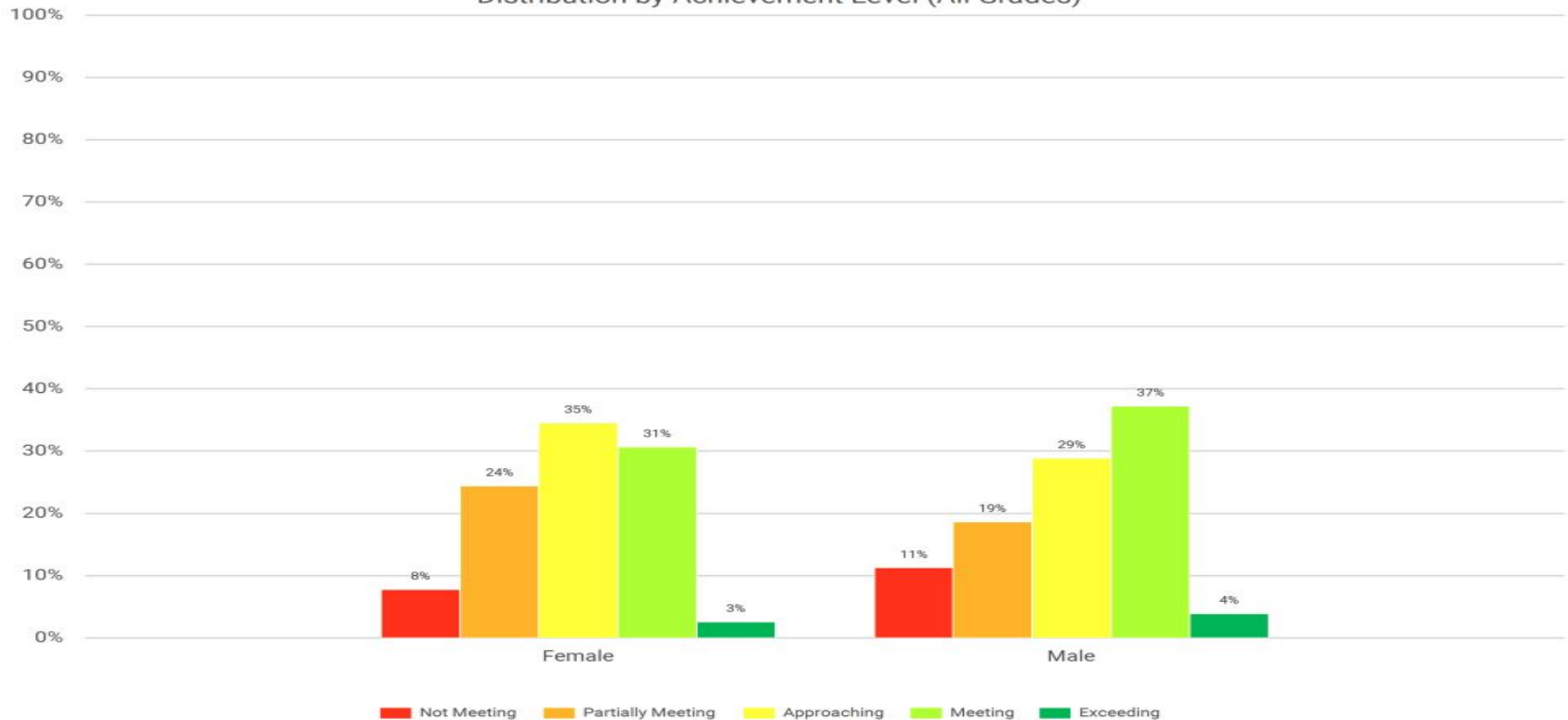
## Little Egg Harbor School District 2024-25 Spring NJSLA by Subgroup Race Math

Distribution by Achievement Level (All Grades)



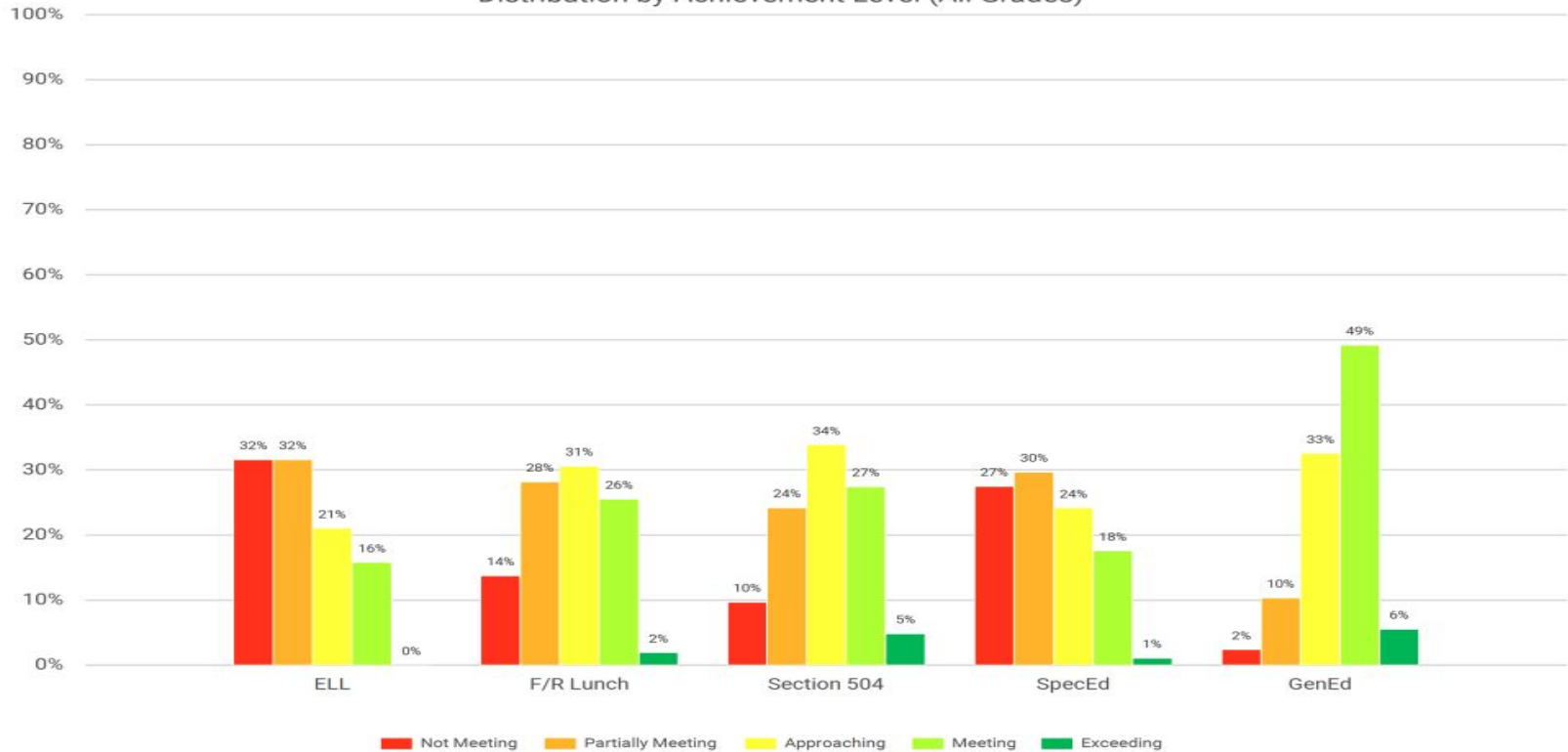
## Little Egg Harbor School District 2024-25 Spring NJSLA by Subgroup Gender Math

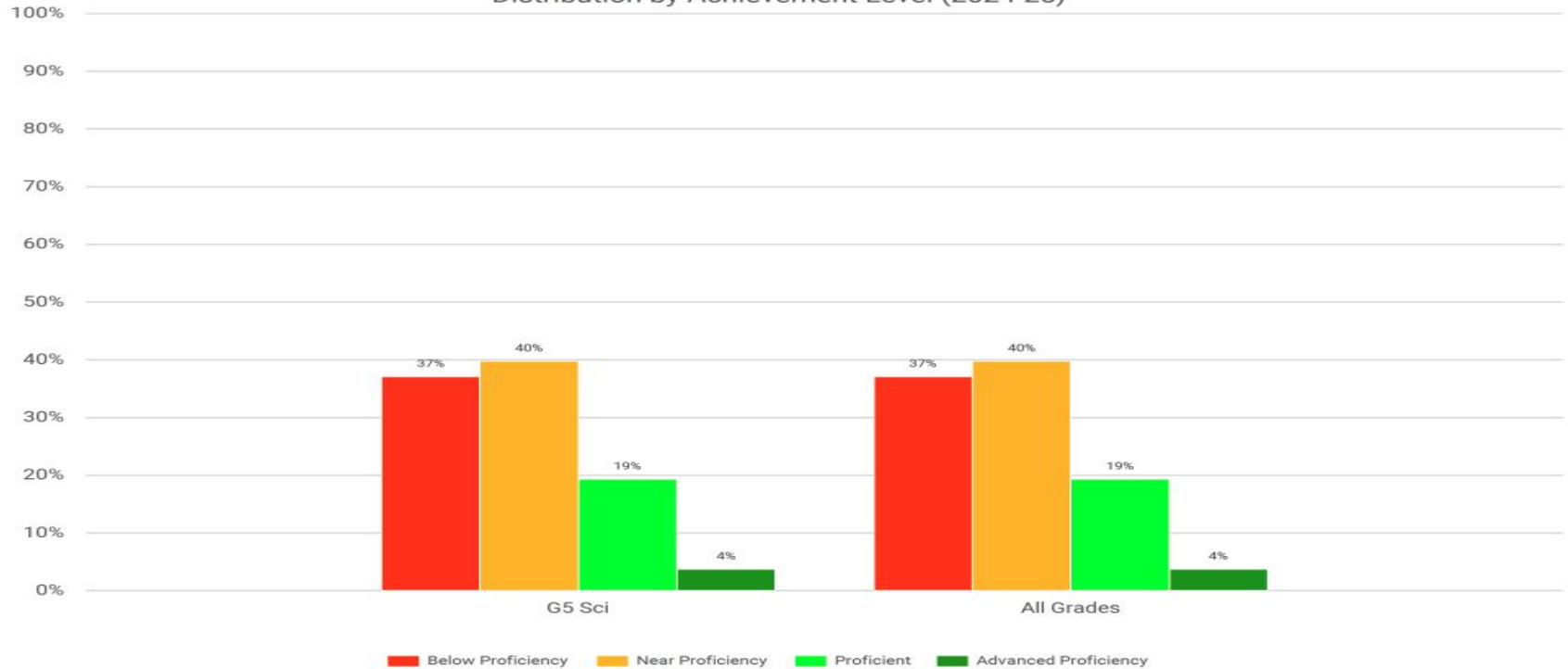

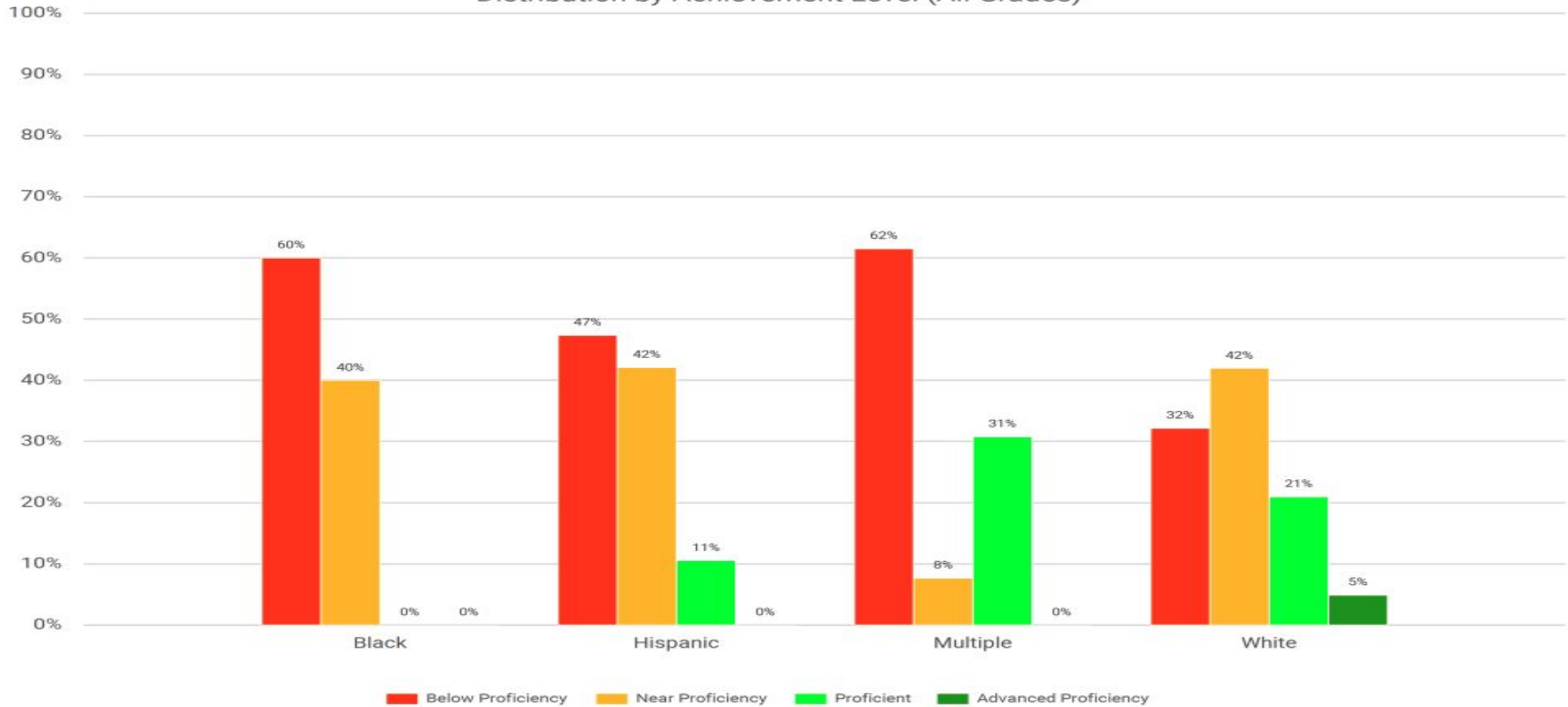

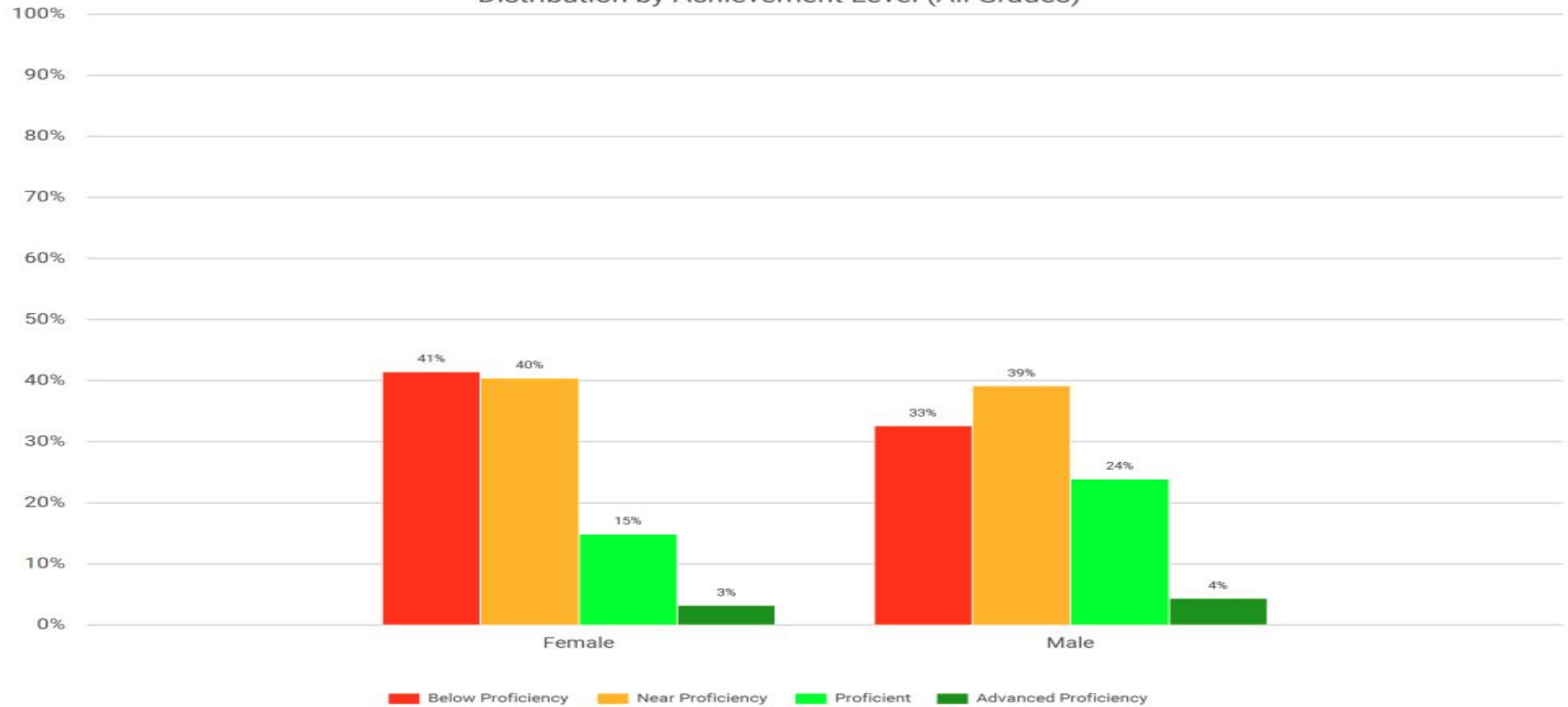
## Little Egg Harbor School District 2024-25 Spring NJSLA by Subgroup Race Science

Distribution by Achievement Level (All Grades)



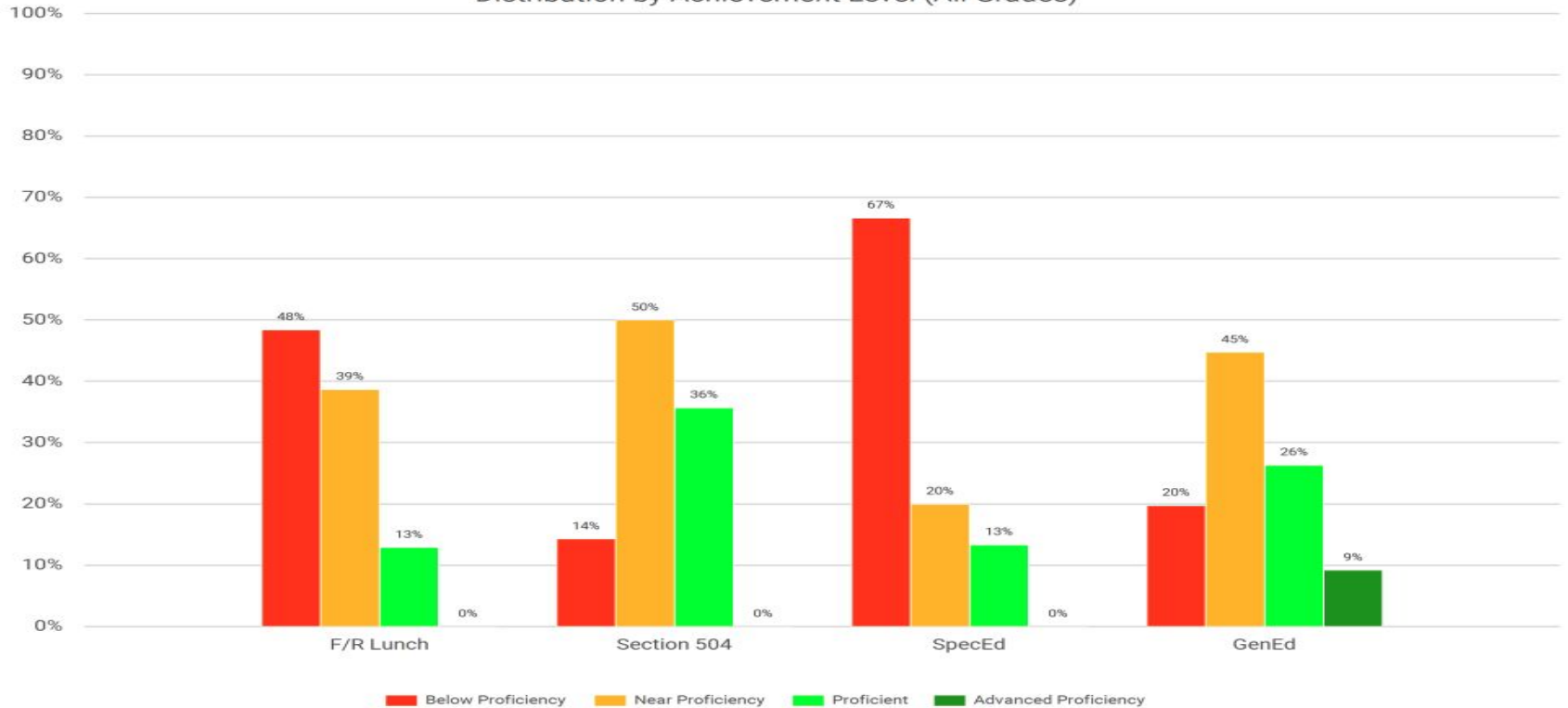

# How Are We Addressing Students' Needs

## **Math**

- Third Year of implementation of the iReady mathematics program for grades K-6
- Daily focus on the math calendar (K-2)

## **ELA**

- K-6 implementing Dibels mClass- universal literacy screener
- Second year of implementation of the Wonders ELA program (grades K-5) and WonderWorks ELA program (grades 2-6) in Resource and Self-Contained classes
- Continue with Heggerty in Grades K & 1- focus on phonemic awareness and Foundations in Grades K-3- focus on phonics instruction
- Continue with Beable in Grades 3-6- targets Lexile Reading Levels
- Just Words and Orton Gillingham programs for Tier III interventions

## **ELA, Math, and Science**

- Provide WINN (K-2) and RTI period- Focus on small group instruction and centers utilizing student data
- Strengthen MTSS- Special Education and Curriculum Collaboration
- ASI supports- targeting at-risk students, implementing small group, and personalized instruction
- Special Education- curriculum is consistent with regular education classes
- IXL- Supplemental resource that targets skills
- Collaborate with lead teachers to focus on data, new programs, and future professional development
- Focus on cross-curricular activities (Wonders- Science and Social Studies, iReady- Science)
