

WV Invests Grant – What You Need to Know

What Is It?

The **WV Invests Grant** is a **last-dollar financial aid program** that covers the **cost of tuition and fees** for **associate degree and certificate programs** at West Virginia public colleges and universities.

It's designed to help students train for **high-demand careers** in fields like healthcare, IT, manufacturing, and more.

Who Can Apply?

To qualify, students must:

- Be a **West Virginia resident**
- Have **not earned a college degree**
- Complete the **FAFSA** (Free Application for Federal Student Aid)
- Enroll in an **eligible program** at a participating WV public institution
- Pass a **drug screening**
- Complete **two hours of community service** each semester

What Does It Cover?

- **Tuition and mandatory fees** not already covered by other grants or scholarships
- It does **not cover** books, supplies, or housing

How to Apply

1. Complete the **FAFSA** at studentaid.gov
2. Apply to a participating WV college or university
3. Choose an **eligible program**
4. Complete the **WV Invests Grant application** through your school

Important Notes

- The grant is **last-dollar**, meaning it pays what's left after other aid is applied
- Students must **maintain good academic standing** to continue receiving the grant
