The Port Orchard Veterans of Foreign Wars Post 2669, on behalf of the Herbert and Gladys Theisen Memorial Scholarships, is pleased to announce that this scholarship is available to graduating seniors from South Kitsap High School, who continue their education in the field of nursing or business.

This scholarship is a total of \$2500 for 1 year, subject to the student satisfying the conditions of the scholarship.

The \$2500 scholarship is disbursed so long as the student maintains a cumulative grade point average of 2.75 or greater in college. A college transcript of grades is required to be delivered to the scholarship committee for verification of the grade point average. The scholarship funds are paid directly to the college where the student is attending.

The completed scholarship application must be turned in to the scholarship committee before May 1. The selection process includes a personal interview with all scholarship finalists. The scholarship recipients will be announced at the award ceremony at South Kitsap High School.
