PROGRAM OVERVIEW:

How might a city inspire, connect and support artists better? New York City is a world-renowned hub for the arts. This program dives into the NYC arts scene, exploring neighborhoods and artistic communities. Visit top art museums, enjoy a Broadway show, meet with artists, discover hidden venues, learn from professionals and even create your own art. What will the city inspire in you?

PROPOSED ITINERARY HIGHLIGHTS:

- Art, Impact, & Industry: Chelsea gallery walk, High Line intro, Broadway show
- Workshops, Music or Performance: Performance workshops, dance and music performances, Jazz evening, Broadway show
- Public Art and Community: Harlem neighborhood introduction, Queens museum options (PS1 Moma, Museum of the Moving Image)
- Fostering Culture and Identity: Brooklyn exploration, museum visits, art workshops (ceramics, glass blowing, street art)
- Lower Manhattan Exploration: Public art, creative memorials, Brooklyn Bridge walk
