**The Louis B. Kopp Scholarship** was established in 2021 by his son and his son's wife, Douglas & Jeanne & Kopp GP '22,'25, to honor the memory of his father.

Louis Kopp was raised in North Kentucky in a loving, Christian family. Always a bright student, Louis enrolled in college after high school. His time in college was cut short by the beginning of World War II.

After the war, family finances prevented him from returning to the university, something that he regretted throughout his life. Nonetheless, Louis, a self-taught engineer, used his skills to help develop a number of successful businesses.

Mr. Kopp believed that faith, kindness, intelligence, and old-fashioned determination was the foundation on which dreams can blossom. Among the greatest gifts he gave his children a strong Christian faith and an appreciation and gratitude for the gift of education.

Kopp Scholarship** will be awarded annually to a promising student who demonstrates the qualities of a "Knight" and recognizes their good fortune to be part of the Village School community. # The Louis B. Kopp Scholarship One (1) \$5,000 scholarship will be awarded annually

#### **Eligibility**

- Open to a student in grades 9-12, renewable
- Applicants must be committed to academic study
- Applicants must have a grade point average of 3.00 or greater, or demonstrate strong academic prowess through teacher recommendations
- Scholarship in the amount of \$5,000 per year
- Demonstrate financial need by qualifying for tuition assistance through <u>MyTVS.info</u>

### Steps to Apply - Deadline: March 1, 2026

- Complete and submit the "TVS All-Scholarship Common Application" Form
- Qualified Applicants will be invited to meet with for a personal interview with the Scholarship Committee and members of Administration
- Students must go through the admission process and be offered enrollment
- Submit a financial assistance application through MyTVS.info

#### Award - Scholars to be announced by May 1, 2026

- One (1) \$5,000 scholarship toward tuition-only
- The applicant may receive financial assistance for remaining demonstrated need (as defined through the official application) - not to exceed total recommended by <u>MyTVS.info</u>

#### **Additional Information**

- The scholarship continues annually as long as the student remains at The Village School and:
  - The recipient demonstrates overall continued academic standing, good citizenship and enthusiasm for The Village School
  - The family remains involved and committed to The Village School
  - Demonstrates financial need each year through MyTVS.info
