- II. Public Comment - No public comment was received.
- III. Approval of Minutes – 5/13/25  
Mrs. Petitti made a motion to approve the minutes May 13, 2025 minutes; Ms. Squicciarro seconded;  
The motion passed unanimously.
- IV. New Business
- a. Policy 5138/Pay to Participate Revision – Dr. Iwanicki discussed the reasons for revising this policy; would like to reduce the amount of forms. If families have been approved for Free and Reduced meals - should be automatic; also indicating the waiver may be used for those experiencing additional financial hardship. Ms. Squicciarro commented on the importance of this document and the work being done; Miss Quiles agreed, stating how happy she is to help and be involved. The wording of the Policy Statement was discussed extensively, with several changes agreed upon and annotated by Dr. Iwanicki. The Appendix was discussed extensively, with several changes suggested by Mr. Wich, Mrs. Prisco, Mrs. Hall and Ms. Squicciarro; changes agreed upon and annotated by Dr. Iwanicki. Dr. Iwanicki will ask Dr. Semmel if the federal form for Free

and Reduced meals may have a slight addition to it which could then reduce the need for the “Addendum.

Mrs. Squicciarro motioned to bring the amended policy to the full Board for review and approval. Mr. Wich seconded. The motion passed unanimously.

Dr. Iwanicki proposed, given the time, to table items “b’ and “c” until the next Policy meeting in December; all agreed.

The meeting was adjourned at 7:05 p.m.
