## **Guidelines for Oregon Eagles Youth Scholarship**

Friday:

Arrive in convention city, North Lincoln, OR. You are staying at Best Western Landmark, 4430 SE Hwy 101. 541-984-6060. You will be sharing a room with other contestants. Check in time is after 3 p.m. All expenses for the hotel and banquets are covered by the Fraternal Order of Eagles. If a contestant from the local hosting city chooses not to stay in the hotel, the Eagles are not responsible for their actions or welfare when not with the chaperones. Once contestant is checked-in with chaperones they are not allowed to leave without prior authorization from chaperone. No matter what your age while a contestant you are not allowed to consume alcohol. There are no drugs allowed. If a contestant does not follow the guidelines, they will be sent home at their own expense.

Saturday:

Competition is at 9 a.m. Please arrive by 8 a.m. At the orientation meeting, let us know if you need time to rehearse. After competition, you will be going with the chaperone out to lunch. The afternoon is your free time to get acquainted. But you are still required to stay with the chaperones and not leave the hotel without prior authorization from the chaperones. A dress/suit or sport coat for impromptu speech and introductions would be appropriate. A costume (if appropriate) or dress/suit or sport coat should be worn for the competition. If your talent does not require a costume, the same dress/suit or sport coat may be used. You will need a short or long formal for Saturday evening banquet for the girls and a suit for the boys. A suit or sport coat and tie or dress or pant suit for the Sunday Prayer Breakfast. No jeans or shorts.

Family and friends are invited to see the competition and they are welcome to attend the no-host banquet on Saturday night and the prayer breakfast on Sunday morning as long as they purchase tickets for these meals.

## FRATERNAL ORDER OF EAGLES YOUTH SCHOLARSHIP CONTEST RULES AND ENTRY FORM MIDWINTER CONFERENCE November 7-9<sup>th</sup>, 2025

1. The contest is divided into two sections. The first section will be judged on contestant's appearance and a two minute impromptu speech, Topics will be drawn from envelopes. One-half point will be deducted for each minute over or under the allotted time.
