

Plan and Procedures for Virtual Learning Days



Students Will:



- Check-in for daily attendance
- Log in to ALL assigned live ZOOM sessions*
- Keep camera ON during instructional time
- Complete and submit assignments daily
- Contact the teacher or school if they need help

Teachers Will:

- Follow school remote day schedule.
- Plan and prepare instruction for virtual learning days and share with students and families.
- Use *Remind* or *Canvas* to send ZOOM links for direct instruction.
- K-6 will record direct instruction sessions.
- Provide synchronous and asynchronous assignments daily.
- Provide daily office hours for students to ask questions about daily assignments.



Pre K:

- Lead Teachers and Assistants will provide 2 live, direct instruction sessions to all students daily.
- ZOOM links will be shared with families through the Remind App.
- Offline resources will be sent home to support online learning.
- Lead teachers and Assistants will check-in with families at least 1 time per week during remote instruction.

Elementary: K-6th Grades

- Families and students will use *Remind* (K-2), *Clever*, and/or *Canvas* (3-6) to access online instruction using the virtual learning schedule provided by the school.
- K-2 students will participate in direct instruction learning sessions via ZOOM with their teacher. Offline resources may be sent home to support online learning.
- 3-6 students will participate in direct instruction learning sessions via ZOOM and complete work assignments through Canvas. Offline resources may be sent home to support online learning.

Ashe County High School & Early College: 9th-12th grades


Students will use *Canvas* to access assignments and ZOOM links using the following daily schedule:

- 10:00 – 11:00 1st Block
- 11:00 – 12:00 2nd Block
- 12:00 – 1:00 Lunch
- 1:00 – 2:00 3rd Block
- 2:00 – 3:00 4th Block



All Schools Will:

- Follow state and local guidelines for virtual learning.
- Communicate with students and families daily.
- Post Remote Day schedules on school and teacher websites and begin instruction at 10:00 am.
- Provide quality, direct instruction to continue learning for all students.
- Provide offline learning materials for students with no internet access*.
- Provide a positive and supportive virtual learning environment for all students.
