Our district uses a Multi-Tiered System of Support (MTSS) to make sure every student has the tools they need to be successful. This system provides different levels of help for students who may need additional academic or behavioral support beyond the scope of what is usually provided to students. The goal is to respond quickly to student needs, reduce barriers to learning, and provide positive strategies for growth.

Based on classroom data, teacher input, and/or initial observations or screenings, your child has been identified as a student who may benefit from extra support through the MTSS behavior process. These supports may include strategies such as structured behavior plans, small group interventions, progress monitoring, or coaching in social and emotional skills. MTSS behavior interventions are not the same as a clinical mental health diagnosis or treatment; instead, they are school-based supports designed to help your child succeed in the classroom and in peer interactions.

For your child to participate in MTSS behavior supports, Texas Senate Bill 12 requires your written consent. You have the right to review the materials and strategies used, and you may withdraw your consent at any time by notifying the school in writing. If you choose not to give consent, your child will continue to have access to general classroom instruction and standard supports available to all students.
