This fall, the District revamped its elementary progress reports to now accurately reflect each student's individualized educational journey throughout elementary school!

As we get ready to debut the new progress reports at next month's Family Conferences, we wanted this week's focus to be on **WHY** the progress reports changed:

CV has always believed the purpose of progress reports is to communicate student achievement and progress toward student learning objectives, but now our new elementary progress reports actually reflect that! They show how a student is progressing towards their ultimate, year-end learning objectives and goals as dictated by PDE standards and our Profile of a CV Learner. Our progress reports are **standards-based** (more on that in the coming weeks!) rather than numbers-
