1 APPLY

Applications are created and submitted online.

A new student application is required for each child applying. A non-refundable \$125 fee is required with the submission of an application.

Required Documents

- Birth Certificate
- Immunization Records
- Report Card History
 - Grades PK-K (1 year)
 - Grades 1-12 (2 years)
- Transcript (for Upper School applicants only)
- Standardized Test Scores for the Previous Two Years
 - Grades 3-8 (STAAR, MAP)
 - Grades 9-12 (ACT, PSAT, SAT)
- Teacher Recommendations
 - Grades K-4 (Homeroom)
 - Grades 5-12 (Math and English)

If Applicable

- Academic Evaluations (504, IEP, FIE within the past 3 years)
 - Students needing support and/or accommodations for dyslexia, dysgraphia, and/or dyscalculia must qualify for and enroll in Academic Center for Empowerment (ACE), a limited-enrollment, fee-based program. Admission and ACE placement decisions are shared on March 7.
- Divorce Decree or Custodial Paperwork

2 ENTRANCE TEST

Entrance testing is required for all applicants and is administered off-site through the following providers. Payment is due to the provider.

4 DECISION

Once steps 1-3 are complete, the application will begin a committee review.

Important Dates

- Sep 1 Applications Open**
- Jan 15 Priority Application Deadline**
Application, testing, shadow, and interview must be completed by this date for priority consideration.
- Jan 31 Priority Decision Day**
Priority admission decisions are announced to families who completed all steps by January 15.
- Mar 7 Decision Day**
Admission decisions are announced via email.
- Mar 25 HAIS Common Reply Date**
If you have applied to additional independent schools, you must accept or decline enrollment offers by this date.

After these dates, acceptance is limited to availability.

Faith Requirements for Admission

At TWCA, we believe that a partnership between the school and home is essential to the spiritual and academic development of our students.

As a Christ-centered institution, we are committed to providing an education grounded in biblical truth. To preserve the unity and integrity of our mission, we ask that families share in and support our core beliefs and educational philosophy.

As part of the admissions process, we require the following:

A. Faith Commitment: At least one parent or legal guardian must clearly profess faith in Jesus Christ as Lord and Savior.

B. Support of Core Beliefs: At least one parent or legal guardian must provide written affirmation of their support for the school's, which shall be done throughout the enrollment process:

- Statement of Faith
- Philosophy of Education
- Policies and practices (to be signed upon offer of enrollment)

This commitment ensures that the home and school are aligned spiritually, allowing students to flourish in a consistent, Christ-centered environment.

The Woodlands Christian Academy partners with families who hold in continual agreement the Statement of Faith:

- 1. We believe in the Trinity:** God eternally exists in three persons – the Father, Son and Holy Spirit – and these three are one God, having precisely the same nature, attributes, and perfection.
- 2. We believe in the full deity and humanity of Christ:** we believe that Jesus Christ is both God and man. Although He is fully God, He was born of a virgin and lived a perfect sinless life as a man.
- 3. We believe in the spiritual lostness of the human race:** all men have sinned and have separated themselves from God by their sin.
- 4. We believe in the substitutionary atonement and bodily resurrection of Christ:** Christ's death on the cross paid the penalty for sin and removed humanity's separation from God. Christ physically rose from the dead and is now seated at the right hand of the Father making intercession for all who trust in Him.
- 5. We believe in salvation by faith in Christ alone:** salvation is a gift of God to all who trust in Jesus Christ as Lord and Savior. We believe that at the time of salvation, the Holy Spirit indwells the believer.
- 6. We believe in the physical return of Christ:** Jesus Christ will one day return in power and glory; the believer will be united with Christ to live eternally in His presence, while the unbeliever will be eternally separated from God.
- 7. We believe in the authority and inerrancy of Scripture:** the Bible is the only inspired word of God and is inerrant by His design.
