Team Selection Process

To provide the greatest breadth of parent and community feedback, representative of the diversity of the district's different cities and neighborhoods, Cheney Public Schools desires representation from each school or school area on the Boundary Review Community Partners Team (BRCPT). To facilitate this, members will be solicited through district communications as well as through each school's communication channels. The following guidelines will be used in selecting volunteer members for the BRCPT.

- Applications will become available October 17th, 2025, and will be due no later than October 31st, 2025.
- Applications can be emailed to mkensok@cheneysd.org or mailed to the district office at 12414 S. Andrus Road, Cheney, WA, 99004. Whether emailed or sent via postal mail, they must arrive by 5pm on October 31st, 2025
- All members selected, as well as any volunteers not selected, will be notified by November 5th, 2025.

The goal for district-wide representation on the BRCPT is:

1. 2-3 members representing the school area, for each of the elementary schools
 - a. 10-15 members
 2. 1-2 members representing the school area for each of the middle schools and the high school.
 - a. 3-6 members
- In the event there is an insufficient number of volunteers from any one school, the school areas may be widened to include adjacent areas to provide for diverse geographic representation on the committee. The District may also appoint representatives to the Team.
 - In the event there is more than the desired number of volunteers from any one school area, and the area does not need to be widened to accommodate adjacent areas due to lack of volunteers, then a lottery will be undertaken to select the members for that school area. The lottery selection will be witnessed and documented to provide transparency in selection
