

SMCC DRESS CODE

Uniform Dress Requirements

Students are to wear items in accordance with the SMCC Dress Code **from Schoolbelles**.
Schoolbelles code is S2123.

Young Men & Women Uniform Attire Options

- **Slacks:** Conventional, khaki-colored dress pants in good repair must be worn. Pant bottoms should be straight or cuffed and cover the ankle (recommended from Schoolbelles or Lands' End but not required) with a belt (recommended). This excludes all jeans, any pants with large pockets on the front or sides, drawstring pants, pants with elastic ankles, or any pants with rivets.
- **Skirt:** Students may choose from the 2 options provided for **plaid** skirts (we no longer will be accepting navy skirts). Skirts must be no more than 3" inches above the or at the knee (for reference use the short side of a 3x5 notecard). Skirts are not to be altered or rolled.
 - **Schoolbelles:** Skirt 3525: Navy/Green Polyester Plaid-158
- **Banded Polo Shirt**–(Schoolbelles) Colors: Navy or Dark Green (short or long-sleeved) with school logo.
- **Oxford Shirt** – (Schoolbelles) Long or short-sleeved in White or Light Blue w/ school logo.
- **V-neck Sweater or Sweater Vest** – (Schoolbelles) in dark green or navy with the school logo, and uniform polo/oxford worn underneath.
- **Cardigan** –(Schoolbelles only) – in Navy with school logo and uniform polo or oxford worn underneath
- **SMCC 3-Quarter Zip Sweatshirt**–(order forms available in the School Office) in Green, Black, or Navy with Jerusalem Cross School Logo. A uniform shirt is recommended to be worn underneath but not required.

Normal Uniform Day Reminders

- Short sleeve or long sleeve undershirts, must be tucked in, and may be worn **provided there are no visible slogans/logos on the shirt.**

Shoes

- Students are to wear conventional black or brown dress shoes that are leather in look.
- Sports shoes, work boots, Ugg boots, hiking or athletic boots, canvas shoes, sandals, moccasins, slippers, and clogs of any color are **unacceptable.**

Uniform Dress-Up Day

Church/Uniform Dress-Up Day (When Mass is celebrated): Students must wear Dress-Up Day Uniform as stated below. If a student forgets and wears the regular school day uniform, the student will be allowed to call home and have a parent provide appropriate attire or the student will receive a Dress Code Violation. All violations will follow the SMCC Behavior Rubric. For Uniform Dress-Up days, the following attire (purchased from the SMCC Dress Code) is required:

Young Women

Uniform Skirt or Slacks
Oxford shirt
School shoes
Socks/nylons
Tie (recommended not required)

Young Men

Uniform Slacks
Oxford shirt (button to top)
School shoes
Tie (top button should not be seen)
Socks
Belt (recommended)
