LEARNING SNAPSHOTS




Year 1 started their new Maths topic and have been using play dough to complete part whole questions. Mrs Harris came and joined the class for part of the lesson and was very impressed with Year 1s use of stem sentences. In English we have been using adjectives to describe the wolf in the three little pigs. In PE the children have continued to enjoy their yoga lessons especially the warm up dances.

Ask me: What is an adjective?




Year 2 have continued their science learning this week about habitats and have investigated how plants and animals adapt to their environment. They have now finished reading George's Marvellous Medicine and the children completed a book review about their favourite part of the story. Reception have been continuing to work hard during phonics and maths lessons. In maths we have been using the word 'composition' which is understanding how numbers are made or 'built' from different numbers. We have been practising the stem sentence '1 and another 1 and another 1 make 3', then the children had the opportunity to find a collection of three things in the classroom.

Ask me: To make a collection of 3 objects from home, then use the stem sentence '1 and another 1 and another 1 makes 3'.
