- ASPIRE scores are what keeps us at #5
- Sept 15 PreACT testing day
- Teachers will receive the test data quickly (within 2-3 weeks)
- Teachers will collaborate during their PLC time, will study the questions and answers
- SCC control Landtrust money, Caleb controls TSSA money
- would like to keep both aligned with each other
- Hired 2 tutors for students to take an opportunity to use, M-F, before, afterschool, during lunch, might add 3 period
- They will assist with Math, English (former teacher)
- Using tutors are student initiated but teacher and parent encouraged
- Parent Release students can utilize tutors, who are stationed in the Mine
- At this point, there is no demand for help afterschool, but can change if needed
- Suggestion made to use Peer Tutors? Caleb will look into it
- How is information passed on? Admin Video Note every month, Newsletter, Miner Morning Show
- Parents can ask their student- Caleb would like feedback on how the information is being received at home
- Student Wellness- working on attendance, social, emotional learning hate speech, students working on lessons regarding this
- Dream Big- paying for summer school, field trips to colleges
- AP Labs-these are being paid for through TSSA monies
- Reader/Grader-used by Tim Jeffrey, AP Geography, very helpful, great feedback
- Teaching Supplies-if teachers need items-TSSA can purchase consumables, Landtrust can purchase items for long term use
- Miner Advantage-using the Wilson Reading program-helps students with reading, get on track

- Teacher PD-Landtrust can fund a teacher who sees a conference that would benefit their teaching and can bring in an outside source
- Suggestion made to possibly make goals more "real", need the data to check where we are, see the results
- Oct 21-PreACT data will be available, compare it to last year's results
- ASPIRE and RISE will be the new data to be reviewed this year
- Will look into gaps in teaching standards from the data
- Question asked if we can see the performance data? Is it tracked?
- Need to get the tutor program established before we can get good data results
