HPHK will have a solid PBIS system in place, including issuing of Hornet Bucks, PBIS store to "shop" using Hornet Bucks and celebrations monthly for students with no discipline referrals for that month. Tier 2 referral system procedures and assistance for behavior.

**Attendance Goal:** HPHK will reduce the number of tardies and chronic absenteeism by at least 5% for the 2025-2026 school year.
