Founded in 1937, the American School of Rio de Janeiro (EARJ) is an independent, non-profit, English-medium day school. An IB World School, EARJ is authorized for all three programmes—the Primary Years Programme (PYP), Middle Years Programme (MYP), and Diploma Programme (DP)—and upholds high professional standards in teaching and learning. EARJ was the first American school established in Rio de Janeiro and is recognized by the U.S. Department of State through its Assisted Schools program, which requires rigorous standards and compliance with U.S. accreditation and child-protection policies. EARJ operates across two campuses—Barra and Gávea.

**CURRICULUM**


**A Dual-Diploma Graduation Model:** All students graduate with both the U.S. High School Diploma and the Brazilian Diploma.

 **U.S. High School Diploma:** Awarded to every graduate at the end of Grade 12; accreditation by Cognia.

 **Brazilian Diploma:** Authorized by the State Board of Education of Rio de Janeiro.

 **International Baccalaureate (IB)** are embedded in the High School curriculum:

 **IB Diploma / Certificates: Grades 11-12**

 **IB Middle Years Programme (MYP): Grades 9-10**

**GRADING SYSTEMS**

EARJ uses a **1-7 grading scale**.

For **IB programmes (MYP, DP, and IB Certificates)**, grades are **cumulative**: each reported grade **reflects progress from the start of the course** up to the reporting date. The **“Semester 2 / Final”** grade **covers the entire academic year**.

**Grade 12 Semester 1** (Mid-Year Report published in late December) **reflects cumulative achievement from the start of Grade 11 through the end of Grade 12 Semester**

Accordingly, **IB semester grades are progress-to-date, not standalone term results**.

In **non-IB High School classes (HS)**, semester grades are **term-bounded**: **S1 and S2 each reflect only the work completed within that semester**.

For the current **Grade 12 cohort**, **MYP implementation in Grades 9-10 was phased**; **HS vs. IB MYP labels reflect rollout logistics, not student choice**.

MYP Personal Project - In the final year of the programme, each MYP student must develop a Personal Project independently, which the IB externally validates. Producing a truly personal and creative piece of work over an extended period stands as a summative review of their ability to conduct independent work.

## CO-CURRICULAR LIFE & STUDENT LEADERSHIP

At EARJ, co-curriculars turn curiosity into action. Students lead, compete, create, and serve across a broad slate of clubs, honor societies, arts, media, STEM, and athletics—each with a clear purpose and adult mentorship.

### Signature areas of engagement

**Competitive Academics & Global Discourse:** Model United Nations, Knowledge Bowl, and the Finance, Economics & Business Club. Honor societies extend academic challenge—Mu Alpha Theta (Math), Science NHS, National Honor Society, and language honor societies in French, Spanish, Portuguese, and Thespian arts.

**Service & Social Impact:** Long-standing, student-run initiatives connect learning to real needs: RASA/Rise Through Education (teaching English to children in Rocinha - Brazil's most populous favela), SOS (Walkathon for the National Cancer Institute), Key Club (Supporting refugees), HOPE/The Give Back Community (supporting unhoused populations), For the Paws (animal welfare), and Sport for Support (donations and community matches).

**Arts, Media & Production:** Yearbook (Carioca), Panther Press, Film Club, Music Production, Art Club, and Thespian Honor Society give students authentic outlets in journalism, design, publishing, performance, and audio production.

**Innovation, STEM & Makerspace:** Innovation Club (design thinking and build projects), Science Exploration, and the Athletics Council/Student Council develop project leadership, teamwork, and community impact.

**Belonging, Student Voice:** The Global Student Association cultivates inclusion and student advocacy across our diverse community, and the Student Council—with elected class representatives and an elected Executive Board—drives student-led initiatives and schoolwide leadership.

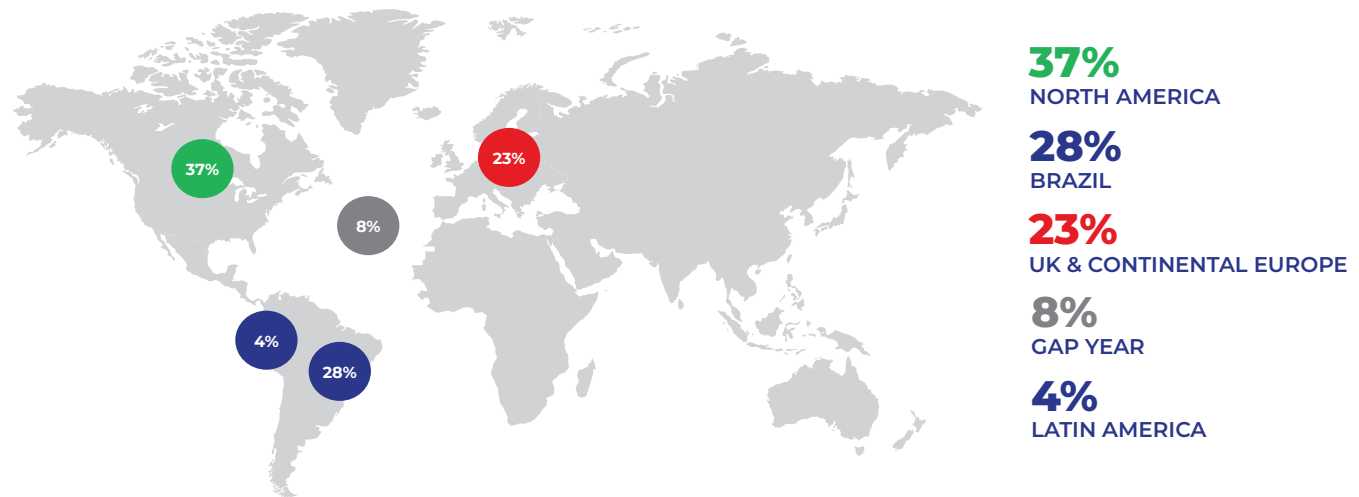
### How it works

Clubs meet during advisory and lunch blocks (with select after-school practices). Every club is faculty-advised and registered with the Upper School; students resolve schedule conflicts directly with advisors and are encouraged to prioritize depth—about three activities weekly—for meaningful impact and balance.

### Outcome

EARJ students graduate not only with strong academics but with a tangible record of leadership, service, publications, performances, competitions, and community projects that travel powerfully into university applications and life beyond.

## EARJ UNIVERSITY MATRICULATION - CLASS OF 2025



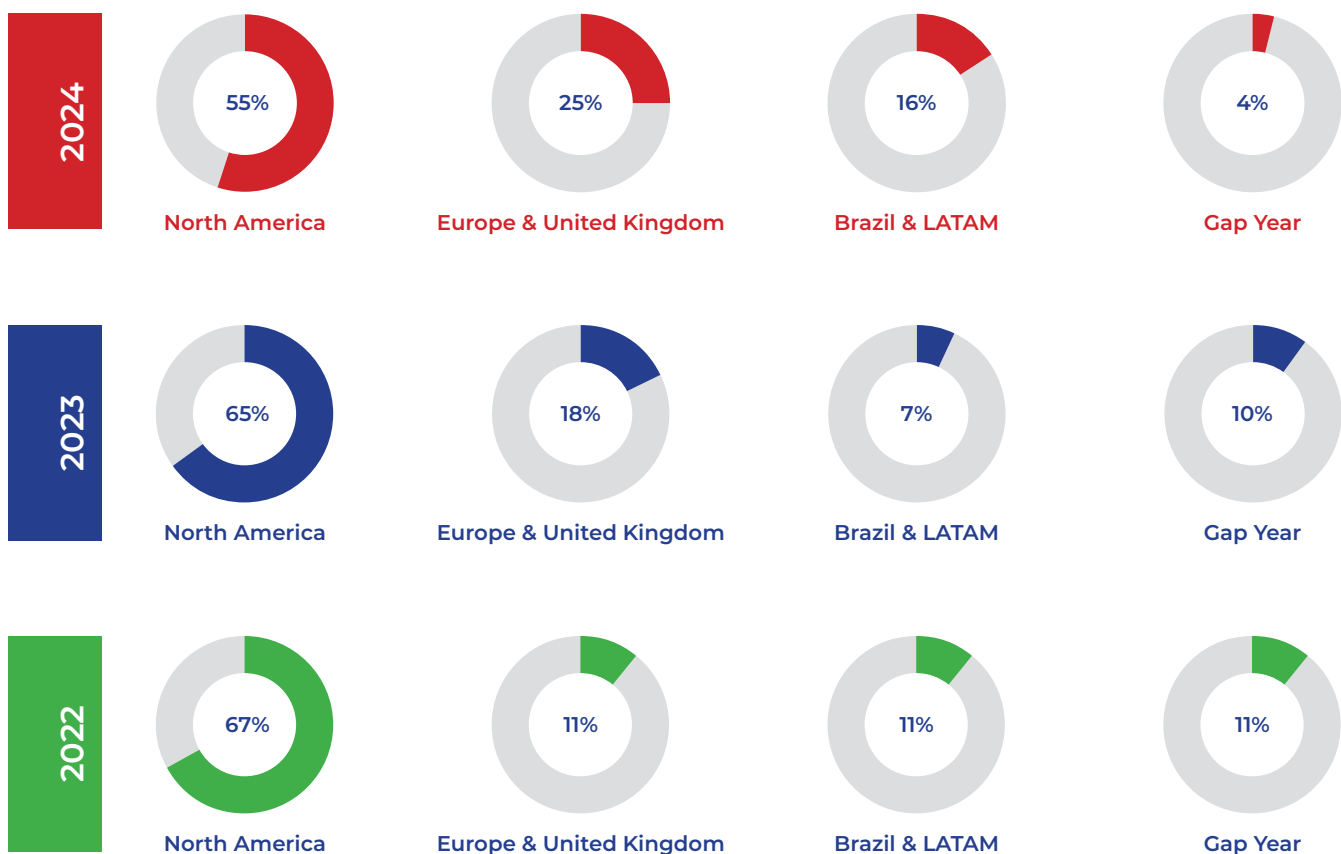
