School earned a B rating as well as all distinctions. The campus earned 8 points from a 76 to an 84 current score.

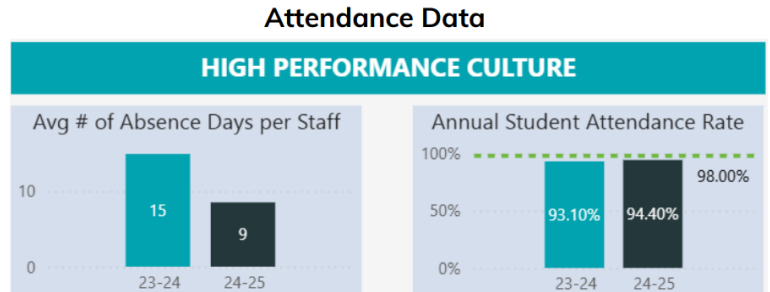
