

### **AP Students!**

- All AVID Students should be taking at least one AP their Junior year (e.g. APUSH, APLang, APES, APBio)
- If you qualify for free and reduced lunch SIGN UP by October 1st
  - You will find a link in your AVID Google Classroom
  - This will allow you financial support for the test
- TAKE THE AP TEST
  - It reflects negatively on your college applications if you don't
- Report your scores!
  - Even if you do not earn college credit for the test, showing you took the tests reflects positively on your college application
