community spirit. Every year, the average score of the IB Diploma (IB DP) is several points **above the global average** (34.3 in 2025).



IB Career-related Programme (IB CP)

- The CP was specifically developed for students who wish to engage in career-related learning while gaining transferable and lifelong skills in applied knowledge, critical thinking, communication, and cross-cultural engagement. It consists of three main components: the core and the career-related studies. Language and Cultural studies is one of the core components along with Personal & Professional Skills, Community Engagement and Reflective Project.


