

- Senior Spots Painted parking spot and must include OHS parking pass.
   (Seniors Only)
- Staff Parking Designated for authorized staff member's only. Clearly marked as STAFF in the parking spot. (Must have New OHS STAFF DECAL)
- Visitor Parking Reserved for Visitors only. (Clearly marked Visitor)
- Handicap Parking Must have a handicap placard.
- Other open spots Must have a current OHS Parking Pass.
