A Message from the Principal

Thank you all for your care and concern and for so many people reaching out this week as Jeffco faced heartbreaking violence. We know this is very upsetting for our community for many reasons. Please know that we at Lincoln are here to support your students in any way they need. Please reach out to our front office, teachers, or mental health team if your student needs any support.

Please know also that school safety is at the forefront of all we do at Lincoln. We have numerous processes and procedures in place to ensure student and staff safety. Thank you for honoring these procedures. As a reminder, these are some of the important rules we ask families to follow at Lincoln Academy:

- All visitors must check in at the front office. Only adults listed on Infinite Campus will be allowed to interact with students, so please ensure your Infinite Campus is up-to-date with approved contacts.
- Only students are allowed between buildings. All adults must remain in designated drop off/pick up spots near the driveline.
- Students are dismissed by Driveline numbers. When there are weather or safety concerns, all students will dismiss from the classroom, so it is important that all families know their Driveline number, even for older students.
- Students who have been signed up to walk off campus at the end of the day must proceed directly off campus to either walk home or meet their ride in the neighborhood, not on campus.
