- 11:30: Student dismissal will begin for grandparents who want to dismiss their students and head out. All other parents can arrive at normal dismissal time at noon to dismiss their students. Walkers will be dismissed at noon as well.

Please note that due to space restrictions, ONLY parents/guardians who are volunteering will be allowed to attend. We are expecting 400-600 attendees, so this is a massive undertaking. We plan to have volunteers as "directors" to make sure that our guests are assisted and directed to the correct locations.
