2025-2026 Registration Open!

Registration is open for Lincoln Academy. This is a required process for Lincoln families and all steps must be completed for all students before they return to school.

Step 1: Complete required annual registration in Infinite Campus

- Forgot your username and/or password? <u>Personal Account Manager</u> can help you reset your account
- Before you get started, we encourage you to read these <u>directions</u> to guide you in completing registration.
- This is the one time of year where you can adjust your FERPA opt-in/out options.
 Please remember to OPT IN to Jeffco publications if you would like your student to appear in the yearbook.
- You will be asked to update emergency contacts for your student(s). These
 contacts are any adults who the school can reach out to if there is an emergency
 and the parents/guardians cannot be reached. They are also how the school

knows who is allowed to pick up your student(s) at the end of the day.

Step 2: While on Infinite Campus, click on "More" to see Quick Links. Here you can:

- Complete the <u>Student Benefits Application</u>
 - Families are not required to complete this form, however all families are strongly encouraged to apply as it will help with additional education funding for the school and may allow families to waive school-related fees
- Pay student fees please note the school yearbook is listed as an "optional fee" that can be added to your student account. This option will drop off the fee list in October and you will need to order it from the school website after that occurs.

Step 3: Complete Lincoln Academy's Registration Checklist

- This registration includes confirmation that you have reviewed and agree to the following items:
 - Lincoln Academy <u>Family Handbook</u>
 - Student/Family/School Agreement
 - Lincoln Academy <u>Student Technology Acceptable Use Policy</u>
 - *Please ensure you review and agree to the <u>Technology</u>
 <u>Acceptable Use Policy Agreement Form</u> included in this link. One
 agreement is needed for EACH student prior to them using
 Lincoln Academy Technology.



Arrival and Dismissal

At 7:35 am, students wanting breakfast can enter through the blue roof doors by the turf field. Staff will be there to help them in the Student Center. After eating, students will be asked to head to the normal entry door for their grade level.

Doors open for K-4th grade students at 7:40 am for a soft start. 5th-8th grade doors open at 7:50 am. Students will enter through these doors when they arrive:

- K-1st: South door of building B
- 2nd-4th: West door outside the main office (near the ALP room)
- 5th/6th: West building C doors
- 7th/8th: East doors outside, behind the gym

As a reminder, the north parking lot is not a drive thru/drop off area. For the safety of our students, this area is intended only for parking and walking your student to or from the sidewalk.

All of our doors are Hug and Go zones as well. Parents are not allowed in the building during arrival. We want to give teachers the chance to welcome their students and start their days with minimal distractions. We appreciate your support with these guidelines.

Dismissal

Dismissal starts at 3 pm for grades K-4 and 3:15 pm for grades 5-8. We ask that families with **any** 5th-8th grade students **not** arrive on campus for pick up until 3:15 pm; if you have younger students, they will wait safely in their classroom until you arrive. If you are in Driveline before 3:15 and are waiting for older students, you will be asked to exit the Driveline and circle around again.

Students are dismissed by their Driveline Number. Your driveline number is unique to each family and tells teachers when they can dismiss each student. Please share your number only with those who are allowed to pick up your student(s). Please visit the front office if you need a hard copy of your Driveline number.

Students Walking for Dismissal

Students may be released to walk off campus at dismissal only with guardian permission. Parents need to <u>complete this form</u> to give their permission for their student this year. **If** you completed the form last year, you will need to submit a new request again this year. Walkers are expected to immediately walk off campus; they should not be waiting on

campus or meeting parents on campus. Walkers may not be left unsupervised after school on the playground.



Parent Academy

All parents and guardians are encouraged to attend Parent Academy.

Please make childcare arrangements so you and others can fully engage in the evening.



School Meals

Students in Jeffco, including at Lincoln Academy, have access to healthy and nutritious meals at no cost, regardless of their income eligibility. Breakfast and lunch will be provided at Lincoln this year. A la carte items will be available for purchase, and money can be added to student accounts using School Café.

Despite meals being served at no cost for all students, families are strongly encouraged to complete a <u>Student Benefits Application</u> on School Café. Completing this application is one of the ways to be considered eligible for other potential benefits the district may offer (i.e. field trip and fee waivers). This also helps Lincoln Academy with further funding opportunities.

How Students will Order a Hot Lunch

Students will let their teacher know at the beginning of the day if they are choosing an item from the menu. <u>Click here</u> for menus, to add spending money to your child's account, and to make any purchase restrictions. Purchase restrictions do not carry over from year to year, so make sure to log back in and reset your restrictions this year.



Attendance at Lincoln

Good attendance is a very important piece of education and we love seeing our students here every day. We understand though that illnesses arise and dentist appointments need to happen. When these circumstances occur, you will need to notify the front office of your student's absence.
