

Grading Period	Unit Topics
Quarter 1 (Aug. 21 - Oct. 24):	Solving one-variable linear equations & inequalities, Concept of a function, Interpreting functions
Quarter 2 (Oct. 27 - Jan. 9):	Linear functions, Linear inequalities, Systems of linear equations, Linear models, Two-categorical data
Quarter 3 (Jan. 12 - Mar. 13)	Exponential expressions, Radical expressions, Polynomial operations, Equivalent quadratic expressions, Solving quadratic equations
Quarter 4 (Mar. 16 - May 21)	Graphing quadratic equations, Independent & dependent probability, Rules of probability, Data distribution

Late Work: You have until the end-of-unit test to turn in any late or missing work **from that same unit.** You will receive 50% of the original grade for any work submitted after its deadline. If it is not turned in or submitted after the unit is over, the grade will become a **zero.**

### **What happens if I miss class?**

1) **Check Schoology** where lesson plans are posted along with recorded lessons, completed notes, assignment descriptions, and any other class activities. *This would also be a good time to ask friends if you have questions about what is on Schoology.*

2) **Email me** with any questions you have about what was posted or if you need help on what was covered during class.
