WAIVER OF THE PROCEDURAL AGREEMENT
between the
EDMONDS SCHOOL DISTRICT NO. 15
and the
EDMONDS EDUCATION ASSOCIATION
2025-2026

THIS WAIVER OF THE PROCEDURAL AGREEMENT regarding **GRADING PERIODS AT SCRIBER LAKE HIGH SCHOOL** (Section 6.7 C) is effective September 1, 2025 through June 30, 2026, and is supplemental to the Procedural Agreement between the Edmonds Education Association and the Edmonds School District No. 15.

WHEREAS 15 years ago, Scriber Lake High School shifted to the year-in-a-semester/semester-in-a-quarter/quarter in-a-session structure; and

WHEREAS this structure allows students to concentrate on 3 block classes at a time instead of six; and

WHEREAS students fare better with only 3 classes to keep track of, have a chance to have a fresh start every 4.5 weeks and students who arrive with credit deficiencies have a chance to accelerate through challenging subjects; and

WHEREAS, on May 23, 100% of the 16 Scriber Lake Staff EEA members voted to request a waiver to return to posting grades every session for the 2025-26 school year;

THEREFORE, the parties agree as follows:

- Grades will be posted every session (middle of the quarter)
- Session Grades: will be posted 4 times per academic year
 - Teachers have 4 school days to post grades after the session closes
 - There will be 2 green days at the end of those 4 days
 - Session 1 green days will be October 8 and 9, 2025
 - Session 3 green days will be December 10 and 11, 2025
 - Session 5 green days will be March 4 and 5, 2026
 - Session 7 green days will be May 13 and 14, 2026
- Quarter Grades: will be posted 4 times per academic year
 - Teachers have 4 school days to post grades after the session closes
 - There will be 2 green days at the end of those 4 days
 - Quarter 1 green days will be November 5 and 6, 2025
 - Quarter 2 green days will be January 29 and 30, 2026
 - Quarter 3 green days will be April 15 and 16, 2026
 - Quarter 4 (no EOY green days)
- Mini-Course grades will be due at the next quarter grades due date.
 - Mini-course exception: Due the Friday after mini-course ends for graduating seniors
- Total number of green days for grading annually: 12 days
