

Student ID Policy

Public / Student-Facing Policy

All Eules Junior High students are required to wear a school-issued ID badge at all times when in the school building.

- ID badges must be worn around the student's neck and visible at all times
- ID badges must be worn with a grade-level-specific lanyard
- Students may not alter or damage their student ID

ANY STUDENT FOUND TO BE USING A PED IS SUBJECT TO HAVING THAT DEVICE TAKEN UP. REFUSAL TO TURN IN A DEVICE WHEN PROMPTED WILL RESULT IN AN IMMEDIATE OFFICE REFERRAL AND IN-SCHOOL SUSPENSION BEING ASSIGNED.

Disciplinary Actions	
1st time	Student can retrieve their device at the end of the school day from the downstairs office
2nd time	A parent or guardian must retrieve the device. A 30-minute detention is assigned.
3rd time	A parent or guardian must retrieve the device. A 1-hour detention is assigned.
4th time	A parent or guardian must retrieve the device. A 2-hour detention is assigned.
5th time	A parent or guardian must retrieve the device. ISS is assigned. The student must turn in their device to the front office each day for the remainder of the year.



How to sign up for Free/Reduce Lunch

The 89th Texas Legislature approved funding through the General Appropriations Act to ensure that students who qualify for reduced-price school meals can receive both breakfast and lunch at no cost for the next two years. State funding for reduced-price meals took effect on September 1, 2025. If you have already applied for and been approved for reduced-price meals, no action is needed. If you have not completed an application for free or reduced-price meals and believe you may be eligible, please do so at www.NLAPPSCLOUD.com.
