Question

Shall Fayette R-III School District issue its general obligation bonds in the amount of \$2,000,000, estimated to result in no increase to the District's debt service property tax levy, for the purpose of acquiring, constructing, improving, repairing, renovating, furnishing and equipping school sites and facilities, including improvements and upgrades to the District athletic stadium, restrooms, and concessions stand?

If this question is approved, the District's debt service property tax levy is estimated to remain unchanged at \$0.7762 per \$100 dollars of assessed valuation of real and personal property.
