
By showcasing the negative effects of drugs and the positive aspects of a drug-free life, this poster encourages everyone to make healthy choices and to unlock their true potential and personal power!


My poster promotes a drug-free life style because it show how addictive they are and how you can't just stop, it also shows that not doing drugs allows you to do things like play sports and just do what you love.


