Q. How do I find my child’s counselor and what college help is available at RHS?

All of grade 9 have the same counselor. Beginning in grade 10, students have two counselors: one social/emotional and one college/career counselor. Here is the counselor breakdown for all grades:

Q. HAC? Schoology? Where are my kids’ grades and assignments? Should I be on one or both of these all the time? Avoid them like the plague?

Q. I heard no one uses lockers. Is this true? What do they do with their stuff?

Every student is assigned a locker geographically located by their homeroom. While, students say, no one uses lockers, lockers are available. If a student declined a locker upon offer, they could still get a locker by asking the front office staff or their homeroom teacher.

Athletics lockers in the locker room are for temporary use provided for students in athletics to store their gear, or during gym class. Locking possessions during sports or gym is **HIGHLY RECOMMENDED**. To support students, PTO sells locks – email rhsptomail@gmail.com

Q. What in the world is LM week and what does that mean for the kids and the parents?

Lower Merion (LM) Week is a week of spirited activities between the longest standing high school football rivalry in the United States. This rivalry is between RHS and LM High School (LMHS). During LM Week, activities occur daily and productions like a pep rally and decorating activities are labor intensive, so parent volunteers are needed. At the end of the week there is a football game between RHS and LMHS.

This year’s game is Saturday, **November 1 at 2pm at Radnor High School**. Students dress up on the theme days (e.g., USA day, Country vs Country Club) and there are plenty of activities. *LM week is a whole-town event that embodies town spirit.* There is also a dance in the evening after the football game. Dress code is casual. This is the only dance that is not a formal affair and while all dances at Radnor are typically a “date” event, many parents are encouraging a new norm to go with friends.

Notably, if Radnor High School wins the football game, on the Monday following the game, the principal grants an early release from school at **12:05 pm – no lunches!** Information will go out to families if we win that weekend.
