It's time to register for the Fulton County Technology Competition!

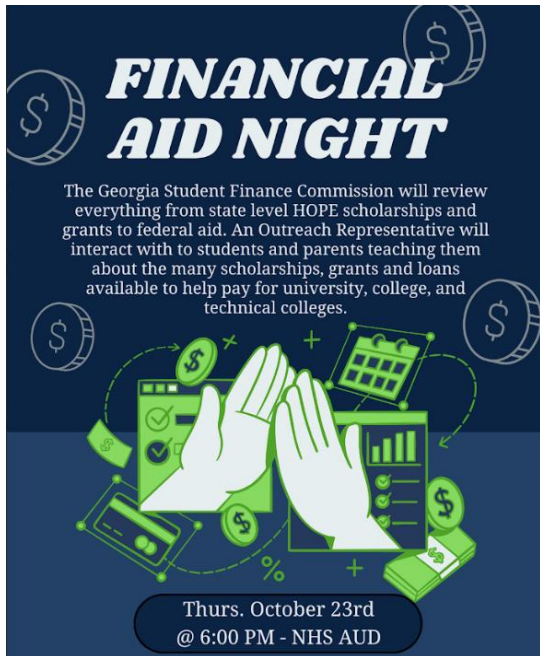
Any students interested in competing must see Mr. Paul in the Media Center to register.

Here are the list of requirements for the books:

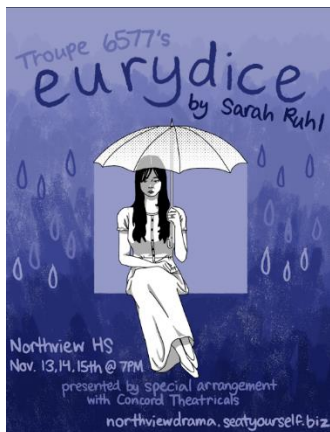
Accepted:
