

**Resolution Recognizing Certain Civic And Service Associations
For The Purpose Of Conducting Small Games Of Chance**

Whereas, the Pennsylvania Small games of Chance Act, Act 195 of 1990, as amended (the "Act"), defines "Civic and service associations" as "[a]ny Statewide or branch, lodge or chapter of a nonprofit national or State organization which is authorized by its written constitution, charter, articles of incorporation or bylaws to encourage in a civic or service purpose within this Commonwealth, which shall have existed in this Commonwealth for one year. The term also means a similar local nonprofit organization, not affiliated with a national or State organization, which is recognized by a resolution adopted by the governing body of the municipality in which the organization conducts its principal activities...The term shall also include nonprofit organizations which are established to promote and encourage participation and support for extracurricular activities within the established primary and secondary public, private and parochial school systems; and

Whereas, such nonprofit organizations must be recognized by a resolution adopted by the appropriate governing body. In the case of organizations associated with the public school system, the governing body shall be the school board of the school district; and

Whereas, the Pine-Richland School District desires to recognize certain civic and service associations pursuant to the requirements of the Small Games of Chance Act, Act 195 of 1990, as amended, and Pine-Richland School Board Policy #707 (Use of School Facilities);

Now, Therefore, It Is Hereby Resolved by the Board of School Directors of the Pine-Richland School District that the following organizations are recognized by the Pine-Richland School district as civic and service associations, as that term is defined in the Act, in that the listed organizations have been established to promote and encourage participation and support for extracurricular activities within the established primary and secondary schools of the Pine-Richland School District:


