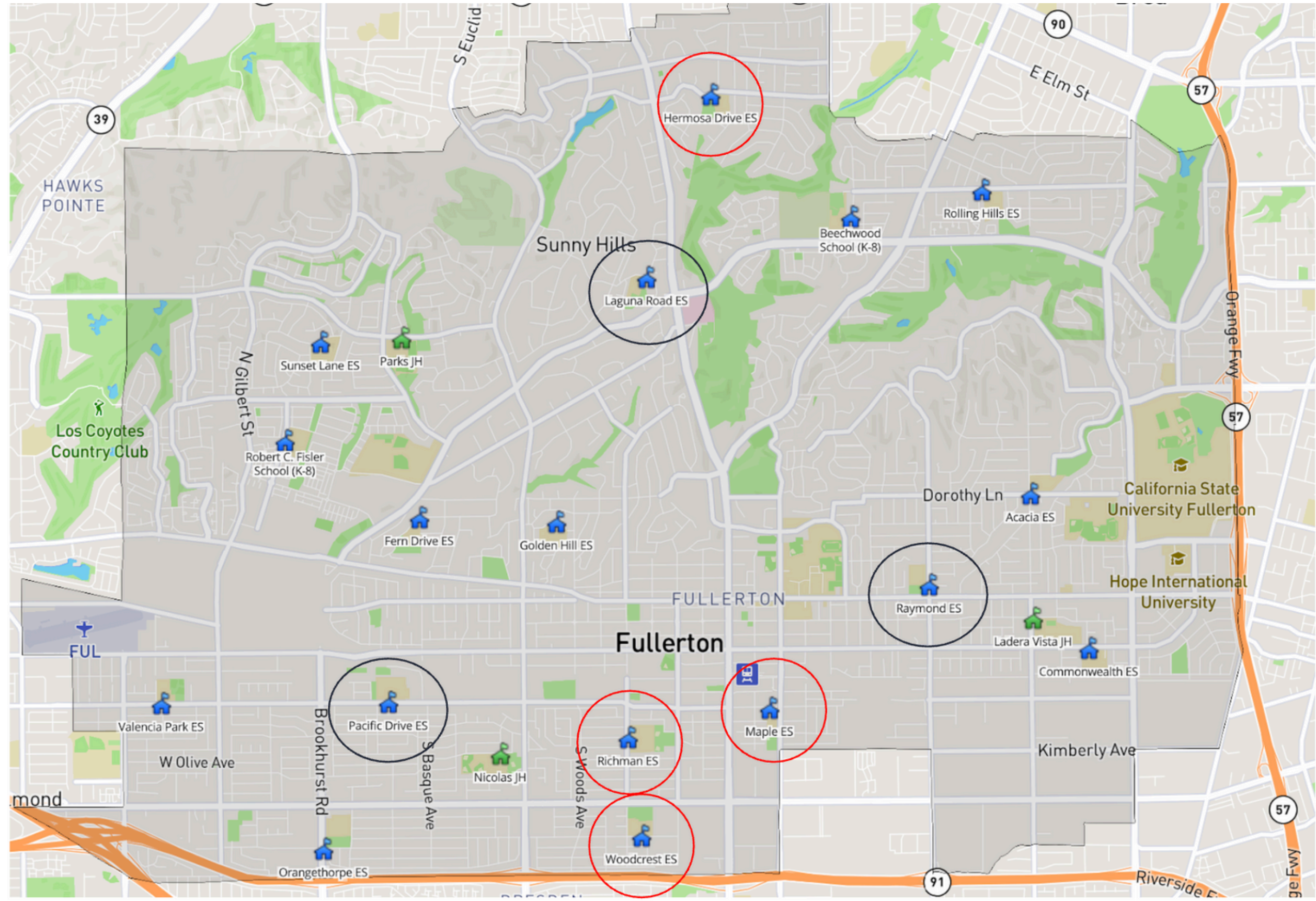
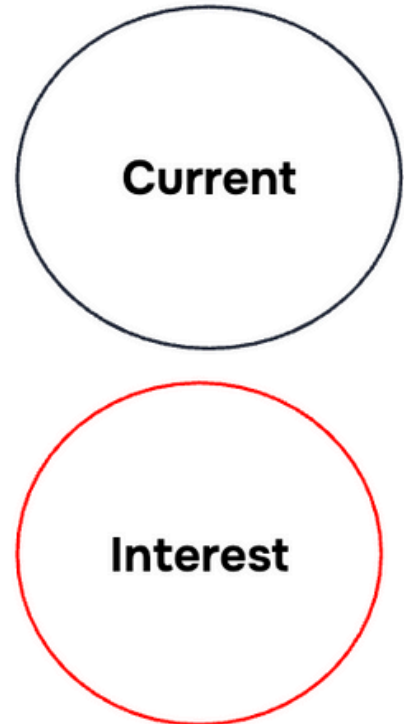

EXPANSION PROCESS TIMELINE

August – November 2025

During the initial planning phase, the Educational Services team will conduct surveys, meet with the community, and do a financial analysis of the addition of a school onboarding a DLA program. The information will be presented to the Multilingual Taskforce and gather input. The final stage of the planning stage is to present and update to the Board.

Form a New Subcommittee

- Members
 - Elementary Parents
 - Elementary Principals
 - Community Members
 - PTA/ELAC Member
 - Teachers
- Review Process including a historical perspective

Survey Community

- Distribute surveys to families at all elementary sites
- Hold community forums to provide information about the process

Site Assessment

- Evaluate physical space requirements at potential sites
- Review neighborhood demographics around potential sites

Meet with FETA/CSEA

- Collaborate with FETA and CSEA to address staffing concerns throughout the process

Financial Analysis

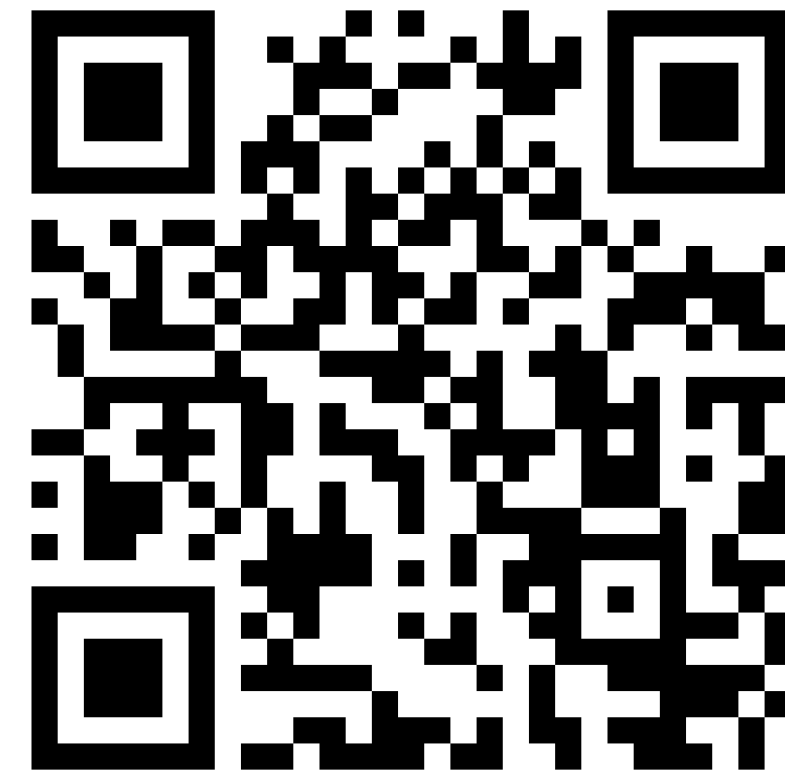
- Determine costs associated with both expansion options
