These schools are among the top ten schools recognized across the state.

Building Updates

South Elementary – Open house/orientation 9/3/25, free breakfast and lunch continues for 25/26 school year.
North Primary – YMCA to offer child care options after school, many counselors are former WASD graduates.
North Intermediate – Locking doors have been installed between the Intermediate and Middle Schools.
Middle School – 6th grade presentation to take place on 8/28/25. Well wishes to Carol Dencker on retirement.
High School – Today is the first day of fall sports. New student welcome tours take place August 29th.
Special Education – In the process of finalizing class rosters.
Each building expressed their deepest gratitude for the custodial and support staffs for the preparation of the upcoming year.

The Board approved the Organizational Chart and several operational handbooks.

Multiple contracts of affiliation and agreements were approved to provide students with quality services from area providers.

Three board policy items were submitted for first review and one policy item was submitted for final review
