<b>Subject</b>	<b>Paper, Exam Board and Paper Length</b>	<b>Any Further Information</b>
Maths	Edexcel Code 1MA1H or 1MA1F for Higher or Foundation. Full set of Papers 1, 2 and 3. Each paper is 90 minutes long.	Each paper is worth 80 marks. The final grade is obtained from the 240 marks available. Grade boundaries change every year. Foundation Tier is for grades 1 to 5 and the Higher Tier is for grades 4 to 9.
English Language	AQA Paper 2 – 1 hour 45 minutes. Non-fiction.	Each Language paper is worth 80 marks. The writing section is worth 40 marks (1 question). Spelling, punctuation and grammar (SPaG) carry 16 marks – accuracy is vital!
English Literature	AQA Paper 1 – 1 hour 45 minutes. 19 <sup>th</sup> Century novel ('A Christmas Carol' OR 'Jekyll and Hyde') plus 'Macbeth'	Two 30-mark questions on paper 1 – one about 'Macbeth' (with an additional 4 marks for SPaG), and one about EITHER 'Jekyll and Hyde' OR 'A Christmas Carol.' Students should be aware of specific contextual factors surrounding the texts (e.g. the gender roles in Jacobean England, the levels of poverty and crime in Victorian England) – however, this assessment objective is worth 20%. The analysis and clarity of argument is worth 40% so developing analysis of methods (and how these shape meanings) is more heavily weighted.

Geography	Eduqas Spec A component 1 paper 1 hour 30 minutes	The paper is worth 88 marks. There are four sections however students only need to answer the following <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Landscapes and Physical Processes</li> <li>• Rural Urban Links</li> <li>• Tectonic Landscapes and Hazards</li> </ul>

		There is an 8-mark question at the end of each section, with the Rural Urban Links one also being marked for SPaG.

GCSE PE	AQA Paper 1 – Whole paper, 1.15hr AQA Paper 2 - Whole Paper, 1.15hr.	Students have studied all of paper 1 and part of paper 2. Paper 2 is a full paper so they know what the paper entails. Some of Paper 2 is common sense so they should approach it the same way as Paper 1.
