The Teacher Apprenticeship Program is a new pathway in Florida for school employees interested in becoming classroom teachers.

This pathway provides an opportunity for those who are interested in becoming a teacher, but have not yet met the Bachelor's degree requirement.

Program Overview

- Apprentices begin as paraprofessionals and are paired with an experienced teacher mentor.
- Apprentices receive on-the-job training and related instruction leading toward a baccalaureate degree and a professional educator certificate.
- Apprentices are not assessed tuition and fees, allowing them to earn while they learn without incurring educational debt.

Requirements

- A.A Degree with 2.5+ cumulative GPA
- 2 years successful employment with VCS
- Must pass 2 General Knowledge Subtests
- VCS Service Agreement
- Cleared background check
- Temp. Apprenticeship Cert. (via FLDOE Statement of Eligibility)
