



## Why are there 3 different GPA's?

Academic GPA (9-12) = Everything except PE

Academic GPA (10-12) = Equal to A-G (College Entrance)

Total GPA = Everything you have completed in High School





\*\*Students must maintain a **2.0** or above GPA to qualify for a Permit to Employ and Work.





