## Annual Notice Regarding the Parents' Bill of Rights (HB 8)

The Ohio legislature has enacted the Parents' Bill of Rights, affirming that parents and guardians have the fundamental right to make decisions concerning the upbringing, education, and care of their children.

In compliance with House Bill 8 and Board Policy IGBLA – Promoting Parental Involvement, Hillsdale Local Schools is providing the following annual notice to inform you of your rights and to allow you to make choices regarding district-provided services.

## **District-Offered Services**

Hillsdale Local Schools provides a variety of physical, mental, and behavioral health services to support students, including but not limited to:

- Health screenings (vision, hearing, dental, growth, and scoliosis)
- Diabetes and seizure care plans
- Concussion and injury assessments
- School nursing and first-aid services
- Counseling related to attendance, social or emotional support, or academic stress
- Threat assessments and safety planning
- Services required under a student's IEP or Section 504 Plan

Parents and guardians have the right to withhold consent or declined services. Declining consent does not affect access to classroom services required by law or by an IEP/504 Plan.	<u>-</u>
