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Annual Notice Regarding the Parents' Bill of Rights (HB 8)

The Ohio legislature has enacted the Parents' Bill of Rights, affirming that parents and guardians have the fundamental right to make decisions concerning the upbringing, education, and care of their children.

District-Offered Services

Hillsdale Local Schools provides a variety of physical, mental, and behavioral health services to support students, including but not limited to:

- Health screenings (vision, hearing, dental, growth, and scoliosis)
- Diabetes and seizure care plans
- Concussion and injury assessments
- School nursing and first-aid services
- Counseling related to attendance, social or emotional support, or academic stress
- Threat assessments and safety planning
- Services required under a student's IEP or Section 504 Plan

Parents and guardians have the right to withhold consent or decline any of these services. Declining consent does not affect access to classroom instruction or to services required by law or by an IEP/504 Plan.
