V.	<p>School Improvement Plan: Area of Focus and Data We are an A school, as well as an A rated District. For next year, we will be focusing on ELA learning gains, our lowest 20th percentile, and lowest 25th percentile We are number 1 in the District for ELA proficiency, top 5 in the District for overall proficiency, number 2 in our SES band for overall ELA proficiency, tied for 7th in the District for K-2 overall proficiency, number 1 in the region for math proficiency proficiency and, number 2 in the District for 3rd grade math proficiency, #2 in the Distrc District it for K-2 math proficiency, increased our sciencescore by 15 points, 9th in the District, #4 in the SES band from last, ELA Overall #21 in the District, Math overall 13th in the District, ELA Lowest 25th Overall we are 98th in the District, Math overall we are 13th in the District, but 58th in the lowest 25th percentile. For improvment, we are looking at data driven instruction, tier 1 instruction, progress monitoring, targeted small group instruction – the Hawk Hustle, professional development.</p>

IX.	SAF Updates SAF helps parents get input into policy and budget. The District is doing a push about redefining the District. There are 39 schools who will be doing something different to help attract students. We lost 10,000 students last year and are working to try to increase enrollment. This removed 80 million dollars from our budget. There is a push in the District to get a full-time nurse in every school. It will cost three million dollars total for every school to have a registered nurse.
