- Specific Academic Ability Testing in Mathematics Grades 2 - 8
 - Student must have scored in the 92nd- 94th percentile on the Fall, Winter, or Spring 25-26 school year on the NWEA MAP Growth Assessment in Mathematics. Students in Grades 2 – 5 utilize the NWEA MAP Growth 2- 5 test and students in Grades 6 – 8 utilize the NWEA MAP Growth 6+ test. Any student who scored in the 95th percentile or above automatically qualifies for this gifted identification and no further testing is needed.

- Specific Academic Ability Testing in Science – Grade 6 (Spring Referral Window Only)
 - Student must have scored in the 92nd – 94th percentile on the Grade 6 ITBS

Science assessment during the current 25-26 school year. Any student who scored in the 95th percentile or above automatically qualifies for this gifted identification and no further testing is needed.
