

Technology Committee – October 6, 2025

The Technology Committee met on October 6, 2025. Mr. Masopust presented an overview of the Technology Department's recent initiatives supporting the District's technology infrastructure and instructional goals. Highlights included the successful upgrade of most District computers to Windows 11 in preparation for the end of Windows 10 support, and the approval of a Smart Schools Bond Act amendment to fund interactive display replacements. The District has adopted the National Institute of Standards and Technology (NIST) Cybersecurity Framework 2.0 to comply with updated Parent Bill of Rights guidance, and deployed Aristotle K12—a new student-centric filtering and classroom management platform—replacing GoGuardian. Additional updates covered collaborative professional development through the Ulster BOCES AI Circle, department staffing changes, and ongoing district-wide technology integration support. Future meetings will address cybersecurity and NIST 2.0 controls in greater detail. The next committee meeting will be held at 3:30 p.m. on November 3, 2025, in high school room 102.
