

Classified Staff Development Opportunities

Classified personnel are an integral part of the District's total staff. Their training and development are essential to the efficient and economical operation of the schools.

Therefore, all classified personnel employees shall be encouraged to grow in job skills and to take additional training which will improve their skills on the job. It shall be the responsibility of all building principals to assist effectively in the training of classified personnel assigned to their respective buildings.

Absences to attend meetings, conventions, conferences, or workshops of local, State or national associations which serve to advance the welfare of the District through the upgrading and strengthening of the support service may be granted by the Superintendent without loss of pay to the employee.
