While past book fairs provided funding for the school library, supporting the collection's expansion and new media programs, Long emphasized the need for change saying, "We can't continue with something that highlights inequalities and goes against the library's mission of providing equal access to information for all."

Long also mentioned, "We are working with our PTO and the Decatur Education Foundation to host future fairs and find new ways to fundraise for the library's programs and collection."

Long added, "This change would not have been possible without support from my school. I am privileged to work for an administration that provides funding for collection development. School libraries must receive systemic funding and support to meet the needs of the students without relying on profit-driven measures."
