

PUBLIC NOTICE
PEMBERTON TOWNSHIP BOARD OF EDUCATION

The Pemberton Township Board of Education will be filling a Board Member vacancy in accordance with N.J.S.A. 18A:12-15(f) and Board Policy 0143 – Board Member Election and Appointment.

Letters of interest must be submitted to Mrs. Laura Archer, Board Secretary, Pemberton Township Board of Education, 1 Egbert Street, Pemberton, NJ 08068 or via email at larcher@pemb.org on or before the close of business (4pm) on November 12, 2025. The length of the term will be December 15, 2025 through December 31, 2026.

The legal requirements to become a school board member:

1. Each member of any board of education shall, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 18A:12-1:
 - a. Be a United States citizen;
 - b. Be a resident of the district for at least one year at the time of election or appointment;
 - c. Be able to read and write;
 - d. Be a registered voter in the district;
 - e. Not be “disqualified” as a voter pursuant to N.J.S.A. 19:4-1
 - f. Has not been convicted of any of the crimes or offenses enumerated in N.J.S.A. 18A:12-1 or conspiracy to commit or attempt to commit any of said crimes. Within 30 days of election or appointment to the board, a member must undergo a criminal history background investigation through the state Department of Education.
2. Board of education members may not, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 18A:12-2:
 - a. Be the mayor or a member of the governing body of the municipality, or;
 - b. Have a direct, or indirect, contract with or claim against the board.

Additionally, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 18A:12-3, if a board member ceases to be a resident of the district, his/her membership on the board shall immediately cease.
