ASVAB Testing

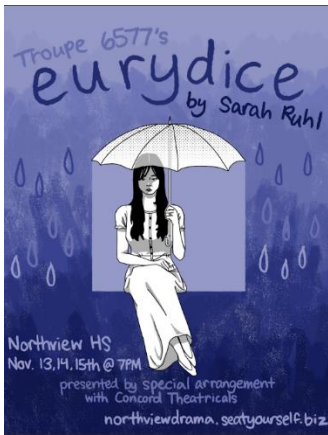
ASVAB testing will be available on Wednesday, November 5 at 8:30 AM.
