What Is a TB Risk Assessment?

A TB Risk Assessment is a short health screening completed by a licensed medical provider to determine whether a full TB test (skin or blood test) is needed.

This free and convenient option meets the TB clearance requirement for VIPS volunteers, helping you complete your clearance quickly and safely.

Why Participate?

- No blood draw or injection required
- Takes only a few minutes
- *Accepted by LBUSD as clearance for volunteering if no risk factors are identified

Who should participate? A new VIP or a current VIP with an expired TB test
